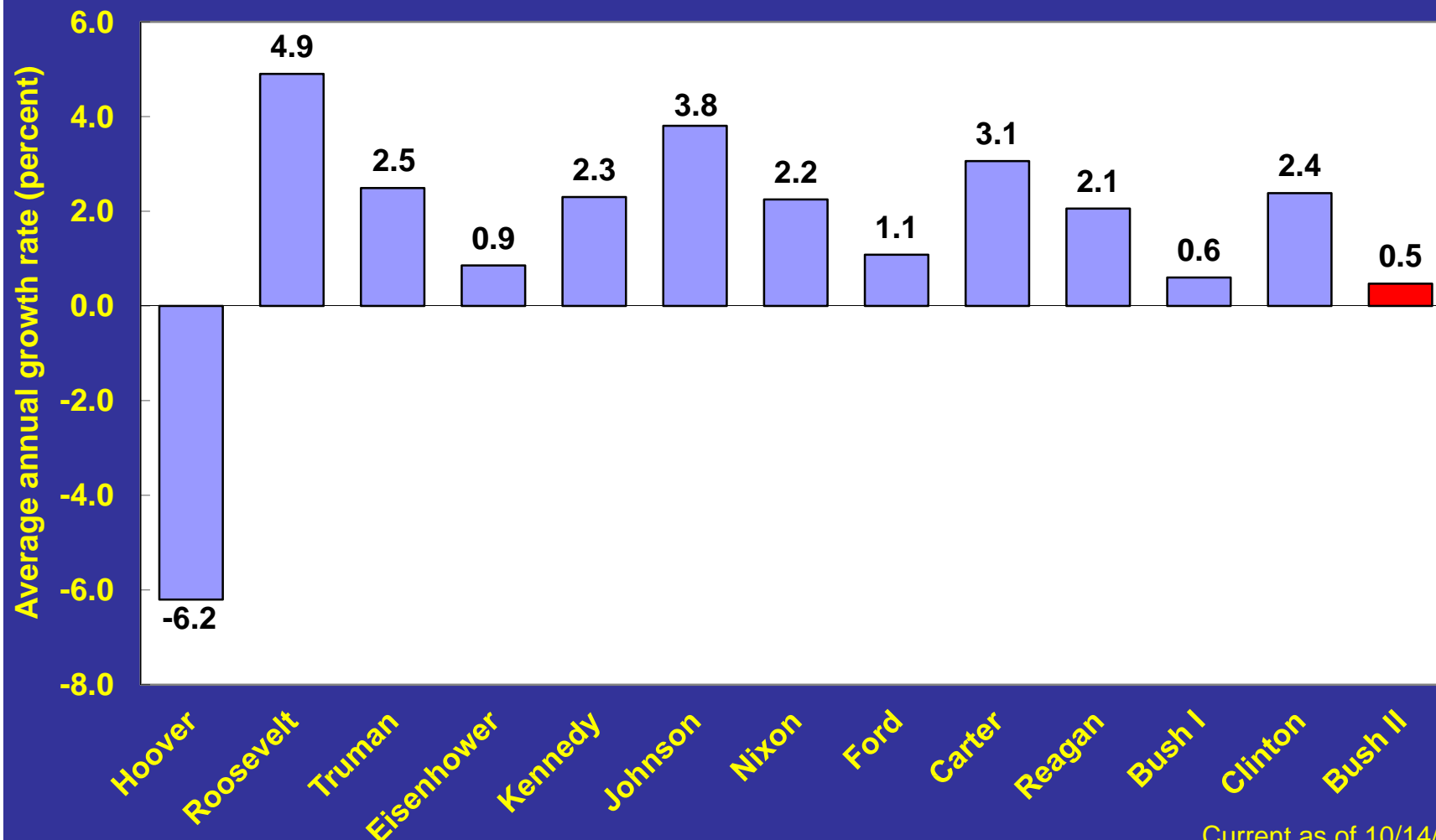


Slowest Job Growth of Any Administration in over 75 Years

Change in Nonfarm Employment



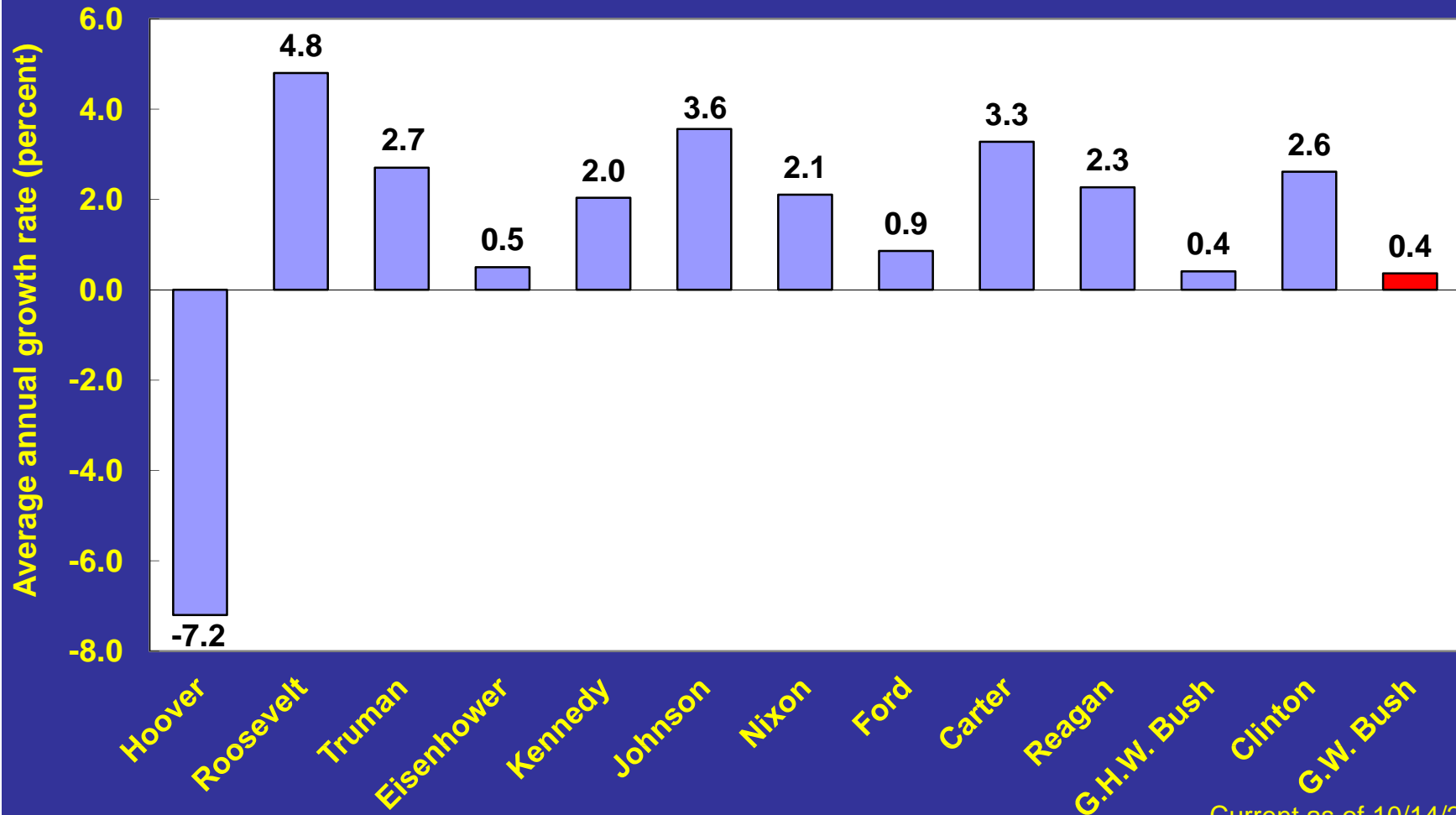

Change in Private Nonfarm Employment



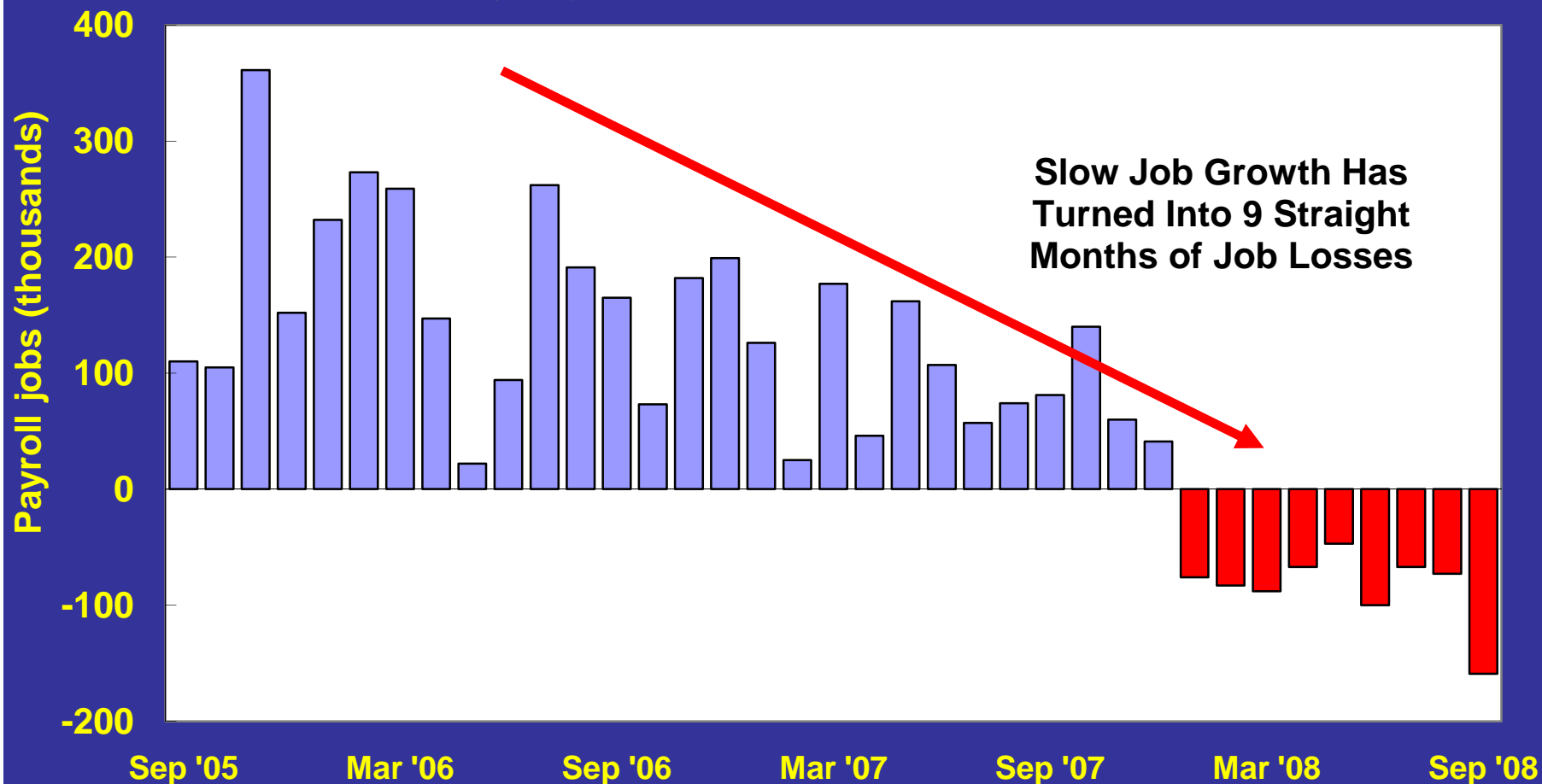

Seasonally Adjusted, September 2005 - September 2008



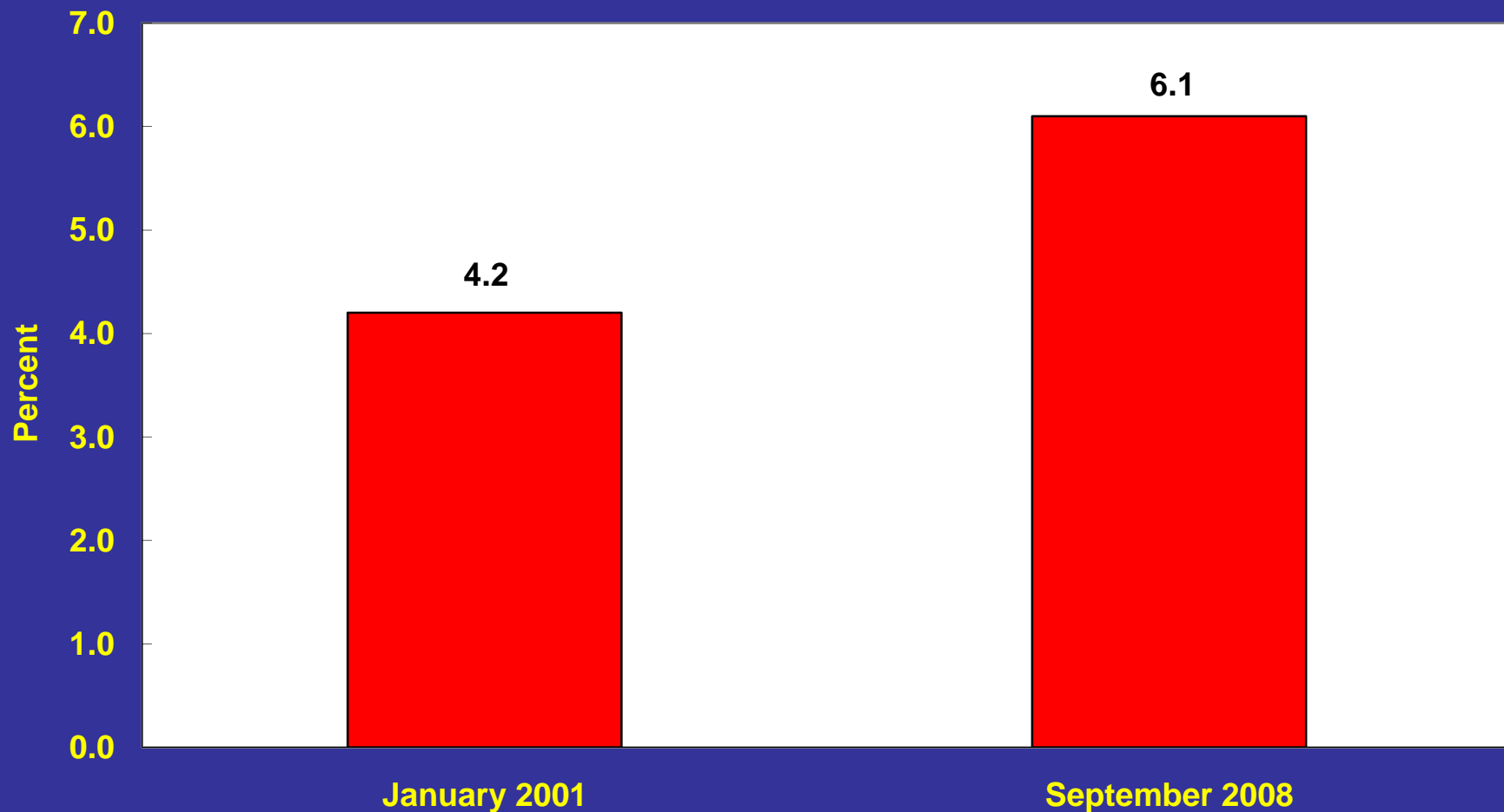

Civilian Unemployment Rate

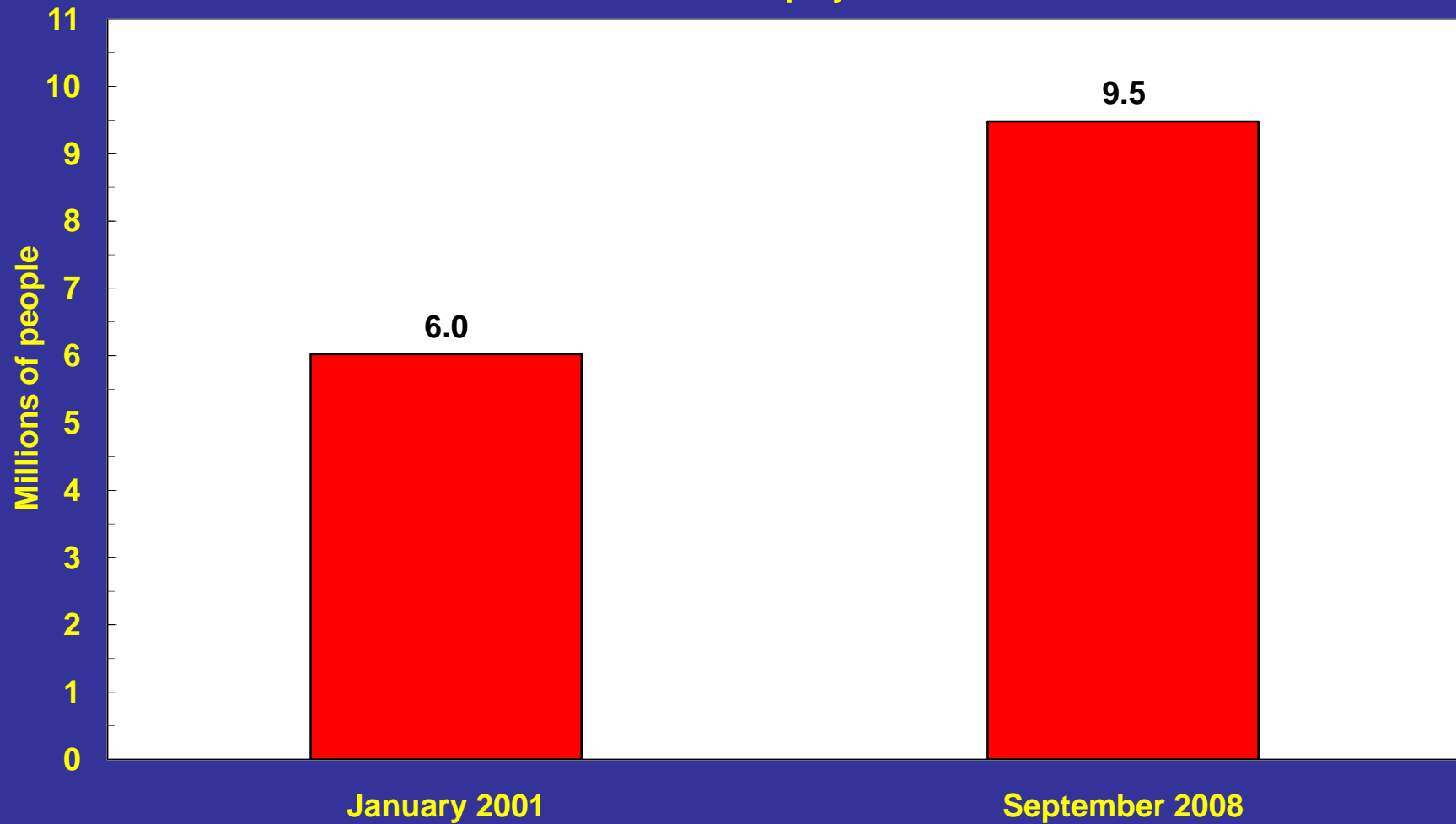

Civilian Unemployment



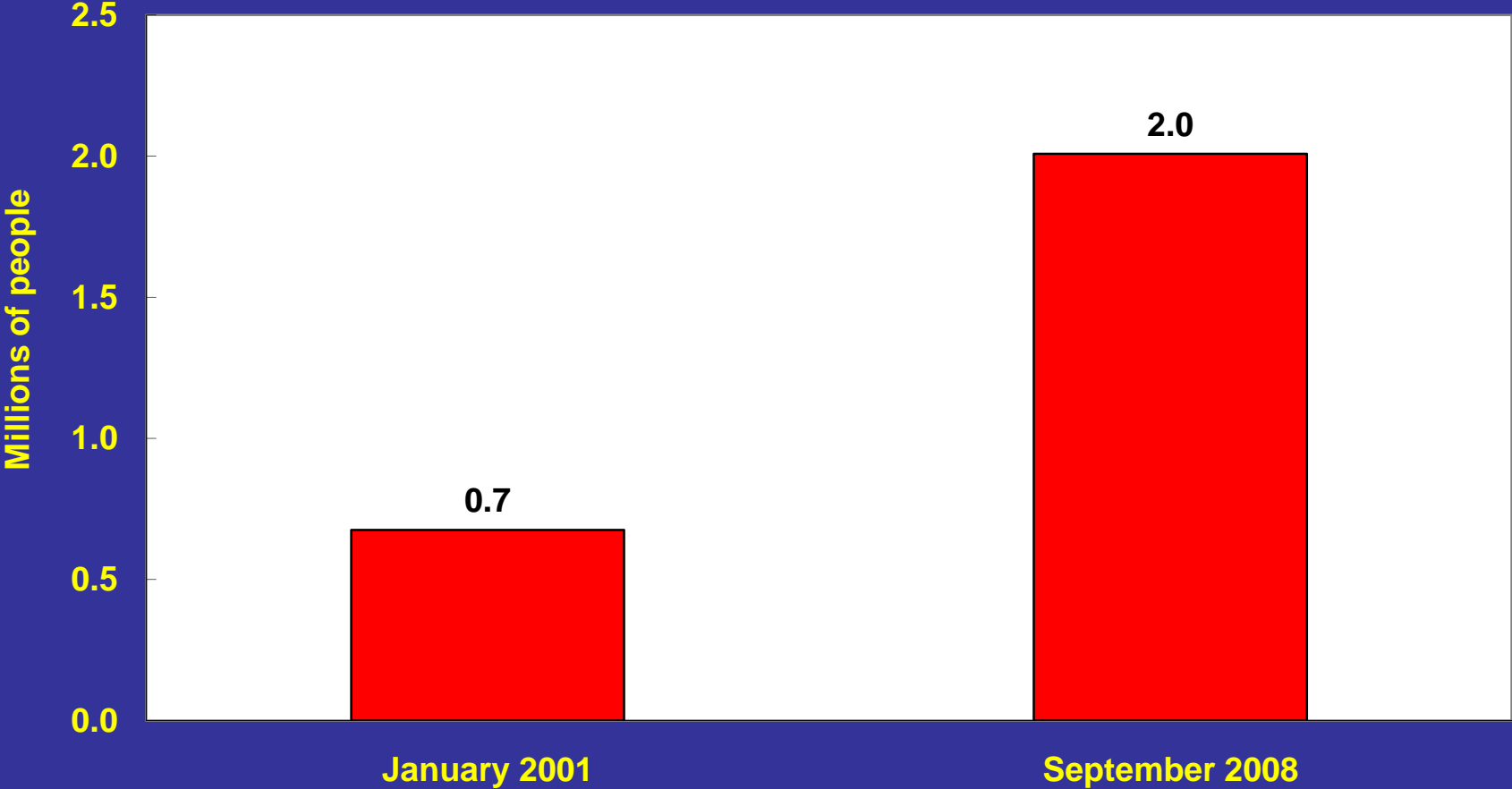

People Unemployed More than 26 Weeks

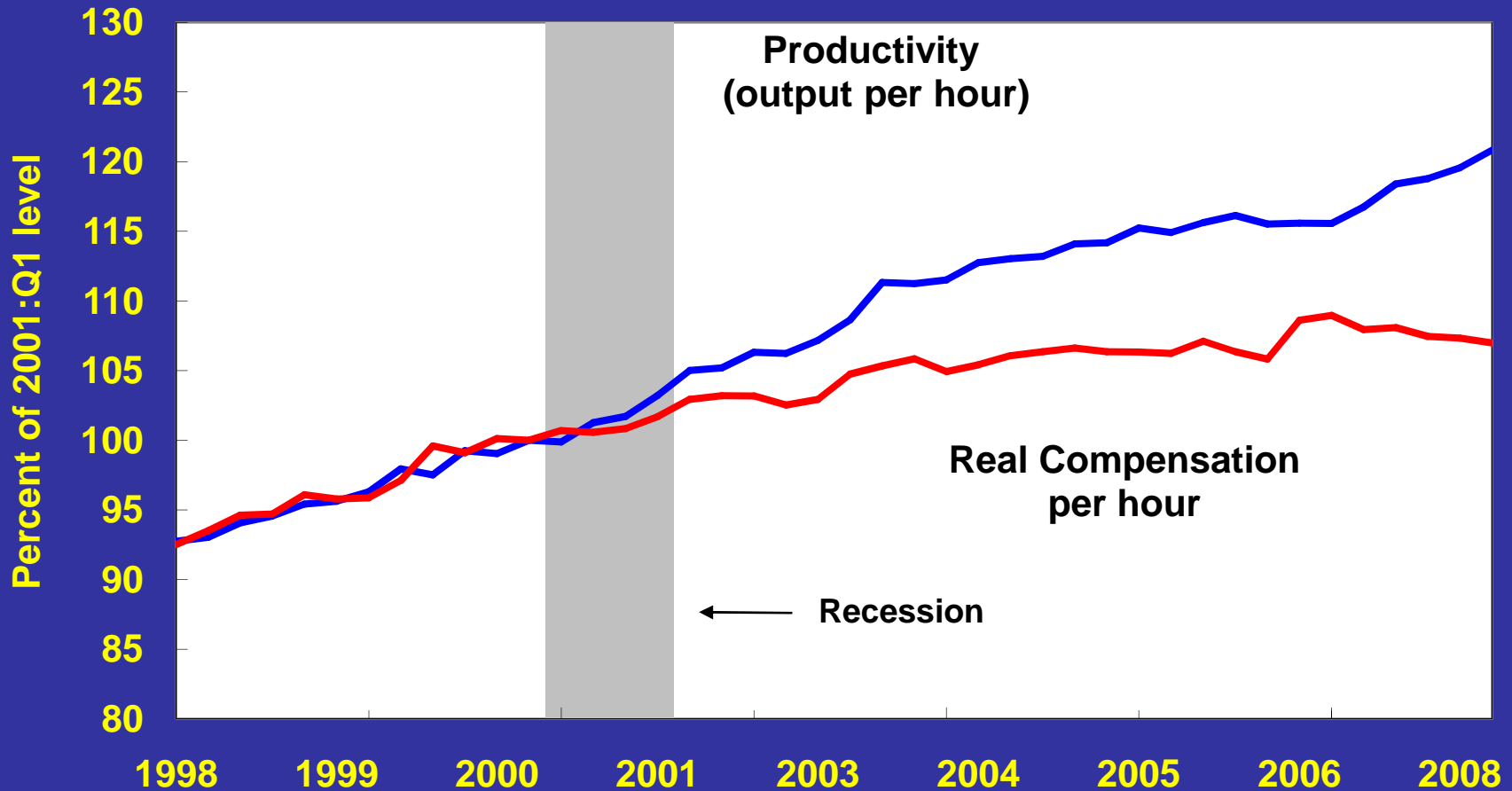

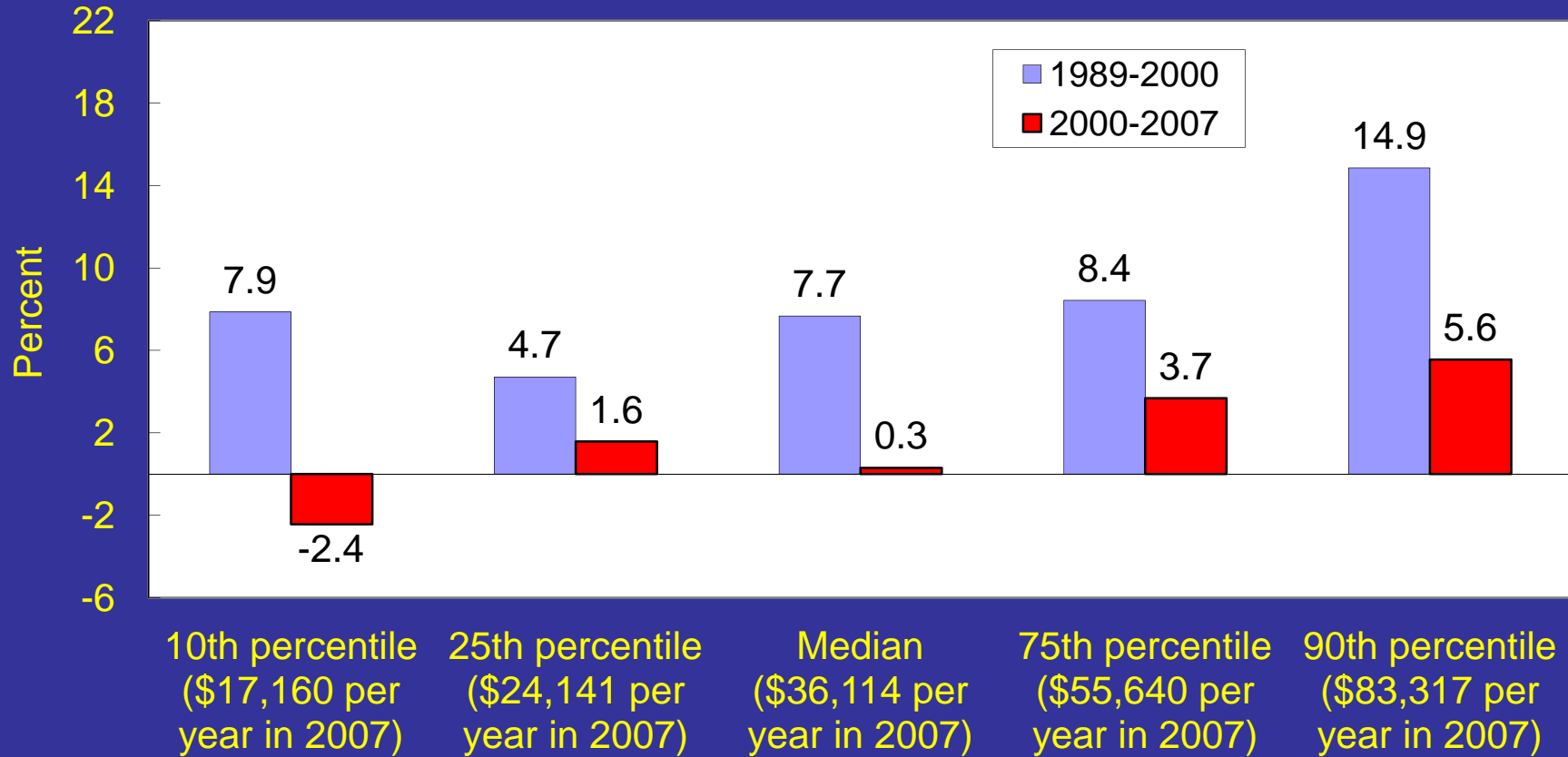

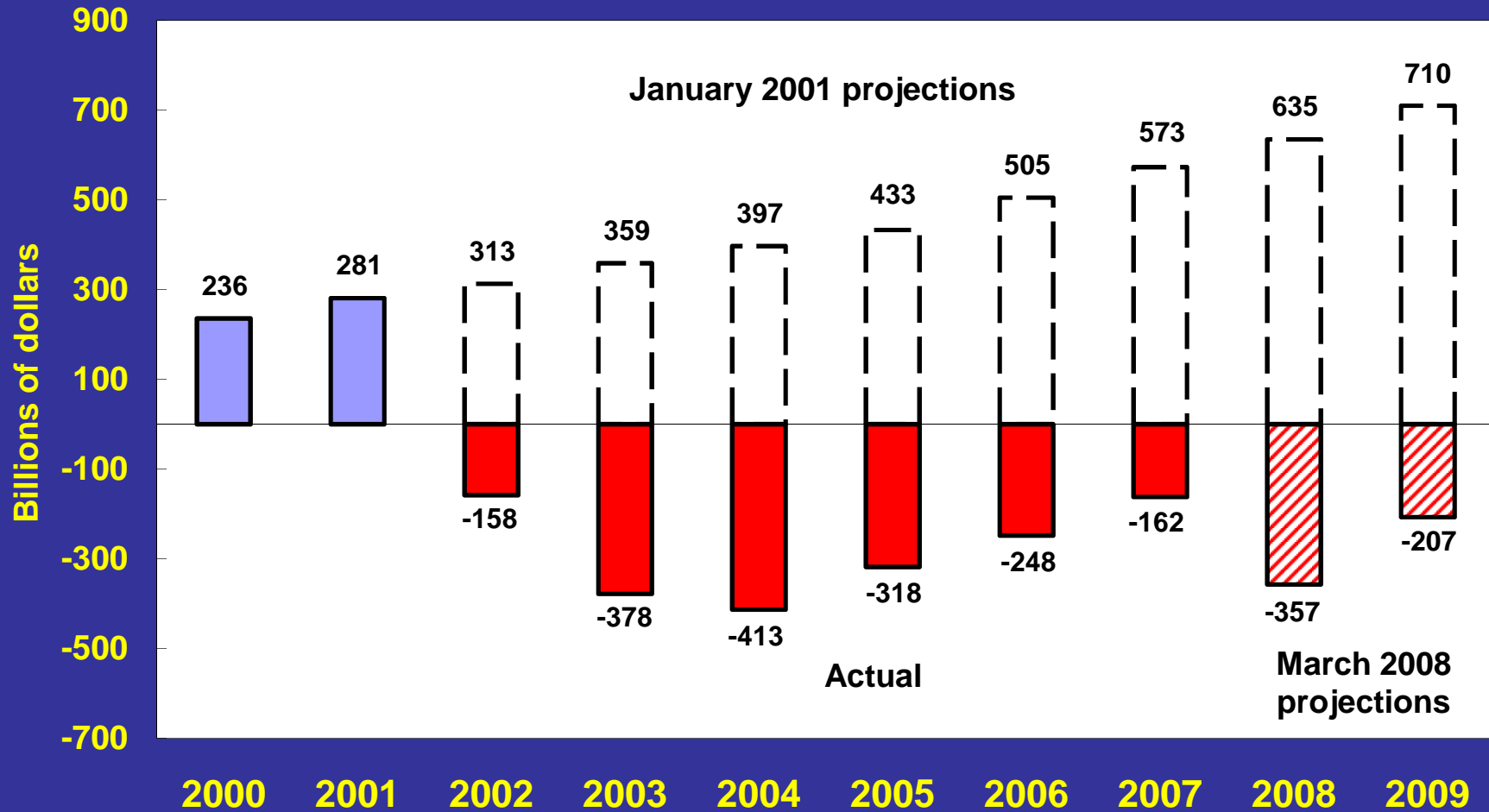

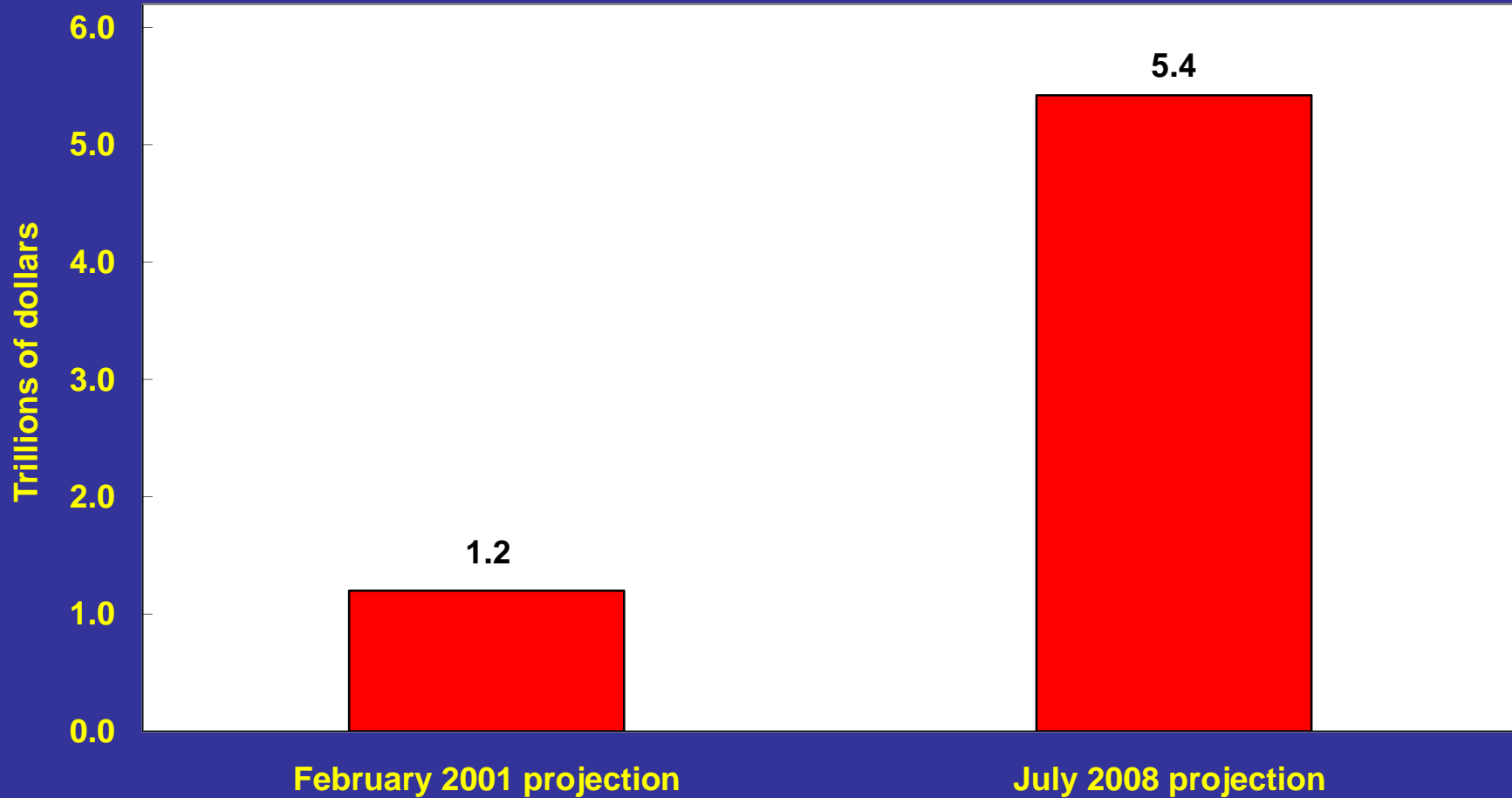

Bush Administration Projections of Public Debt in 2008



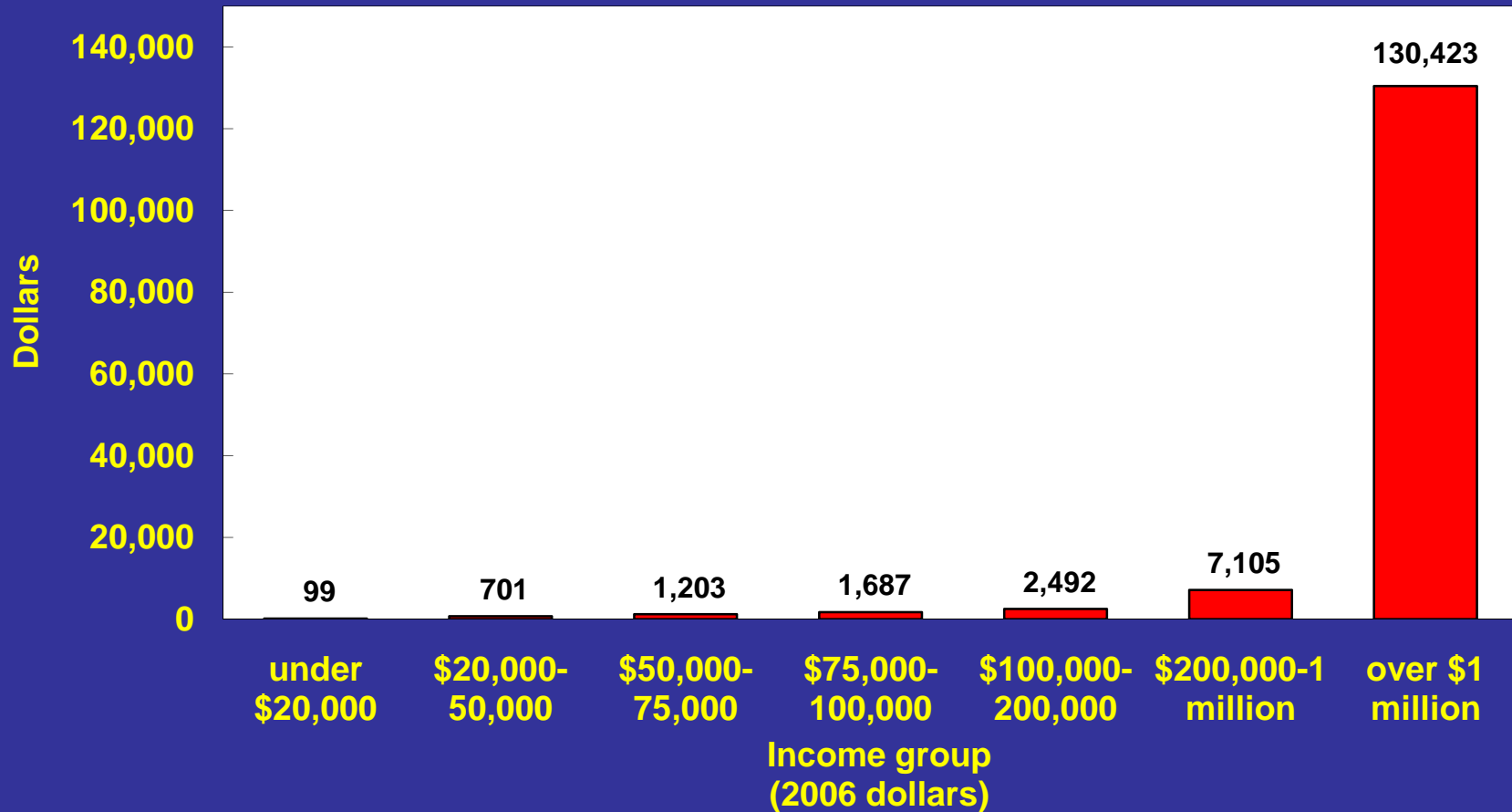

Average Amount of 2001-2006 Tax Cuts by Household Income, 2008

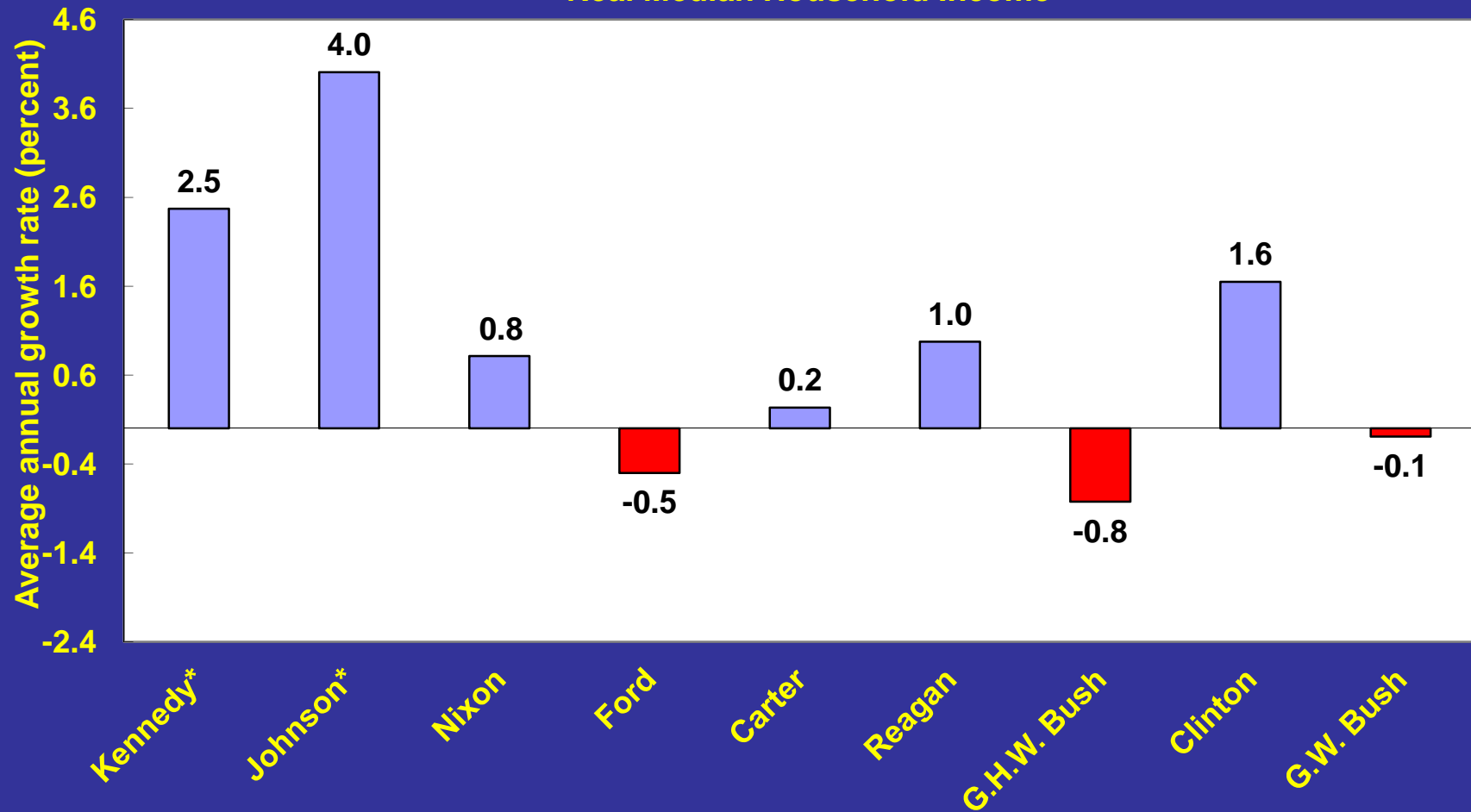

Real Median Household Income



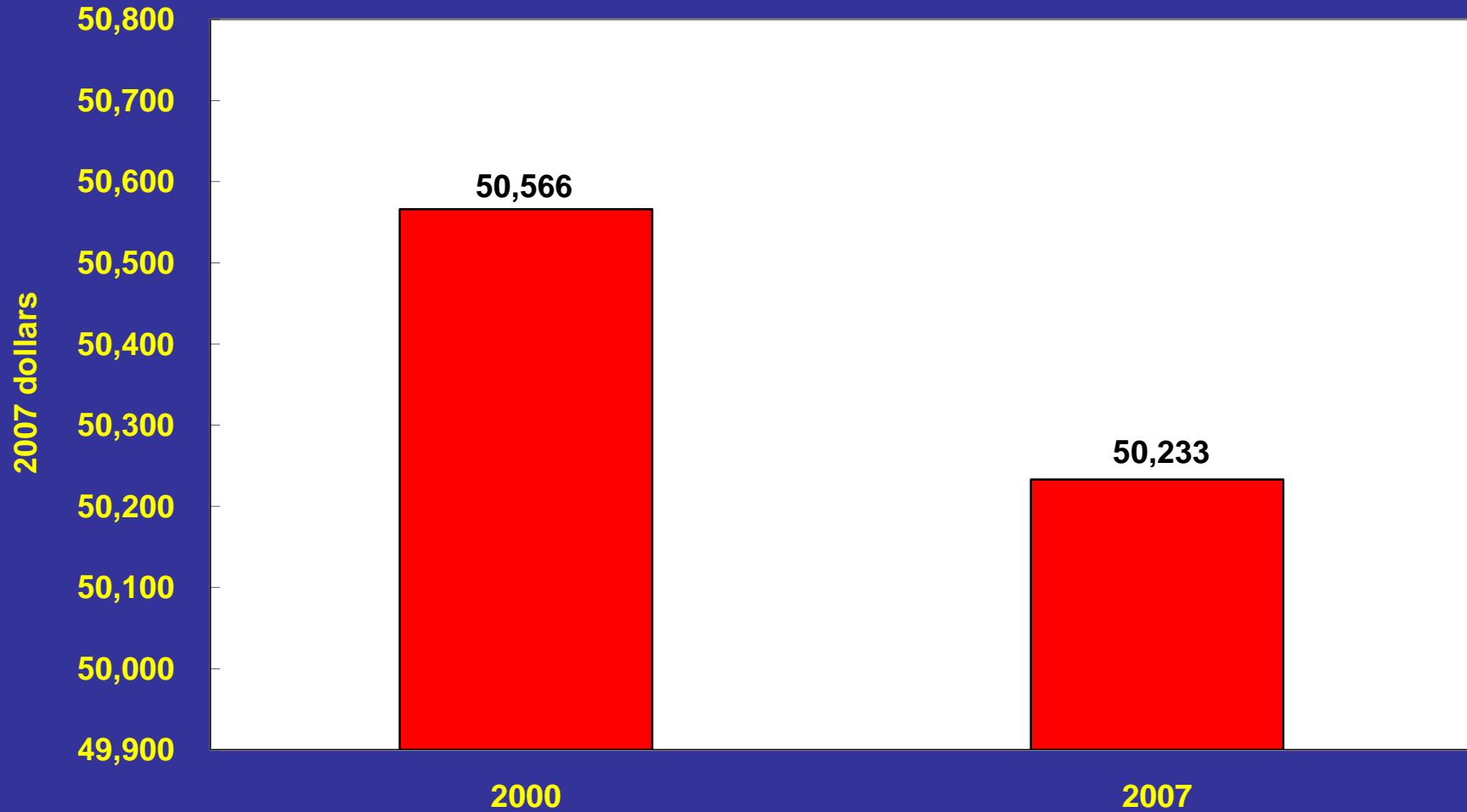

Real Median Household Income

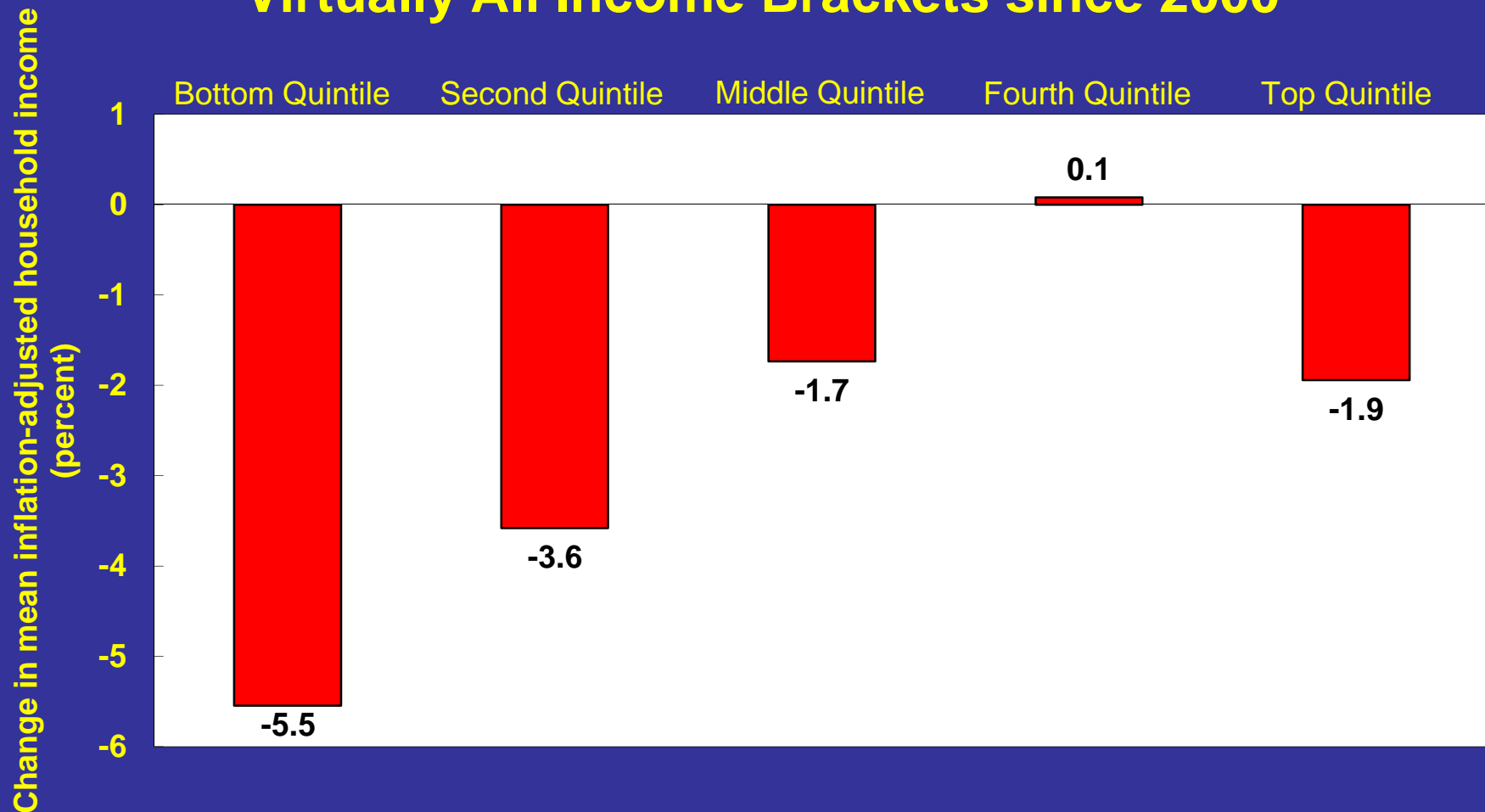

Real Household Income Has Declined for Virtually All Income Brackets since 2000

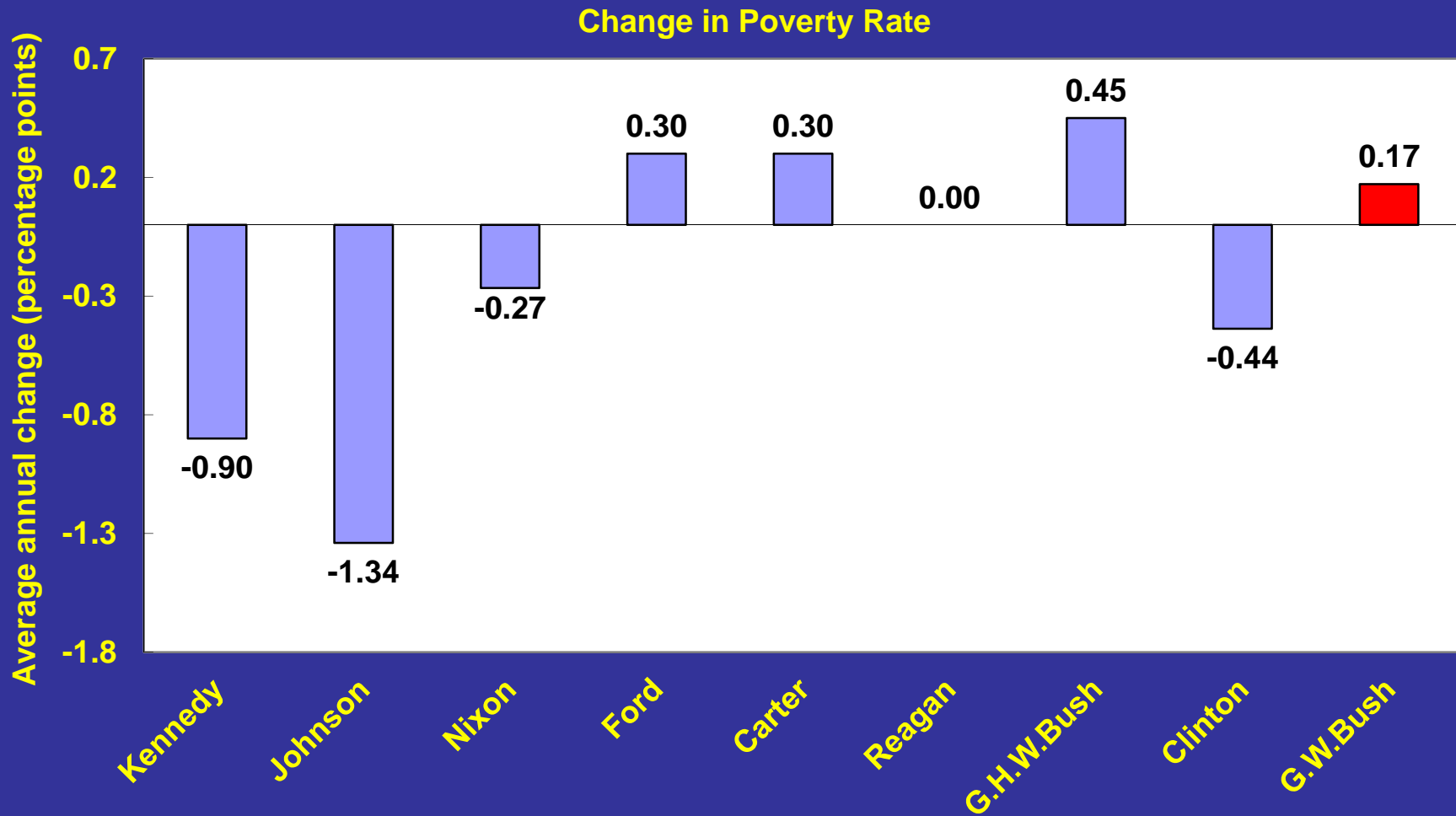

The Poverty Rate Has Risen Under This Administration



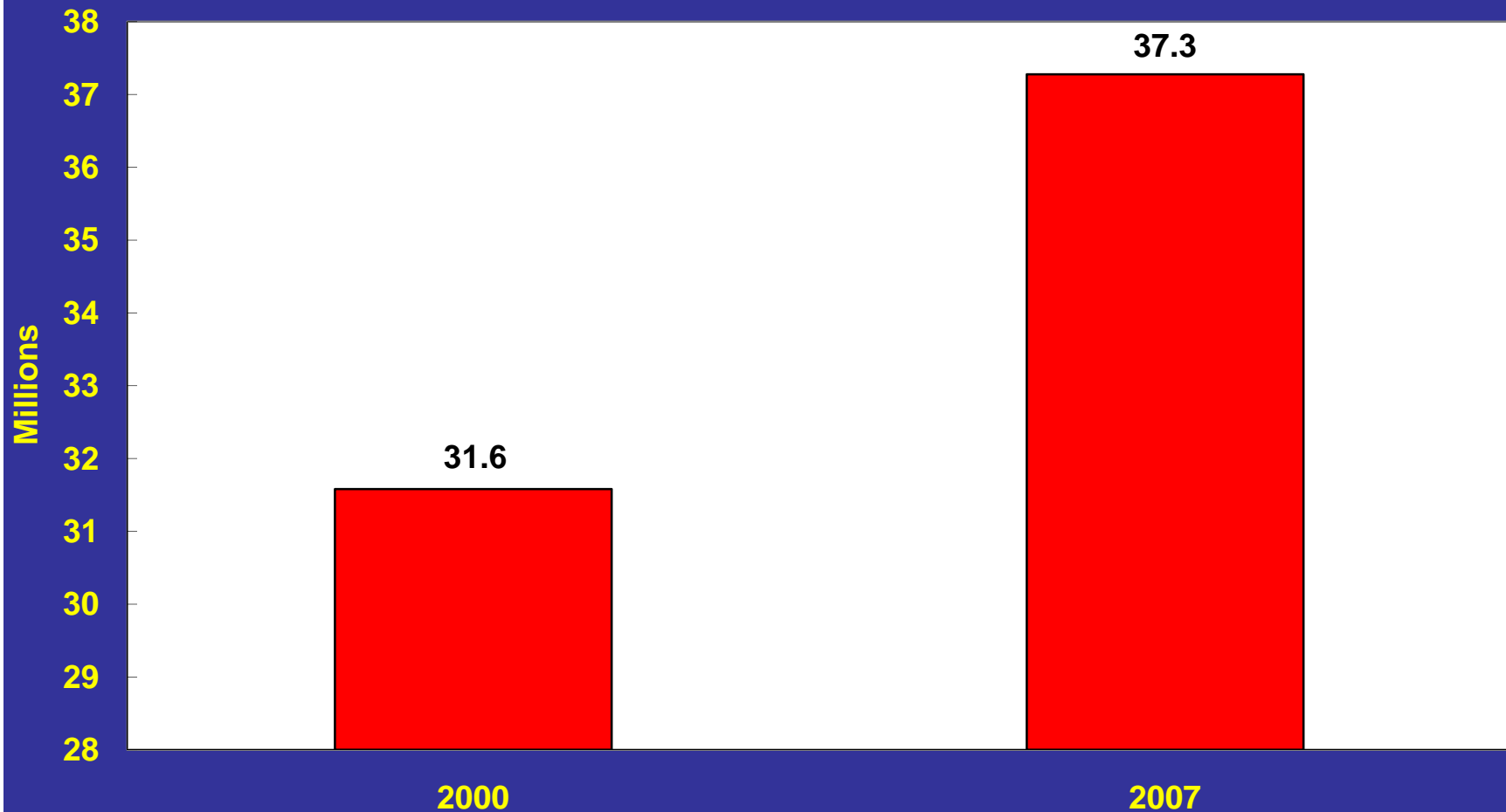

Number of People in Poverty



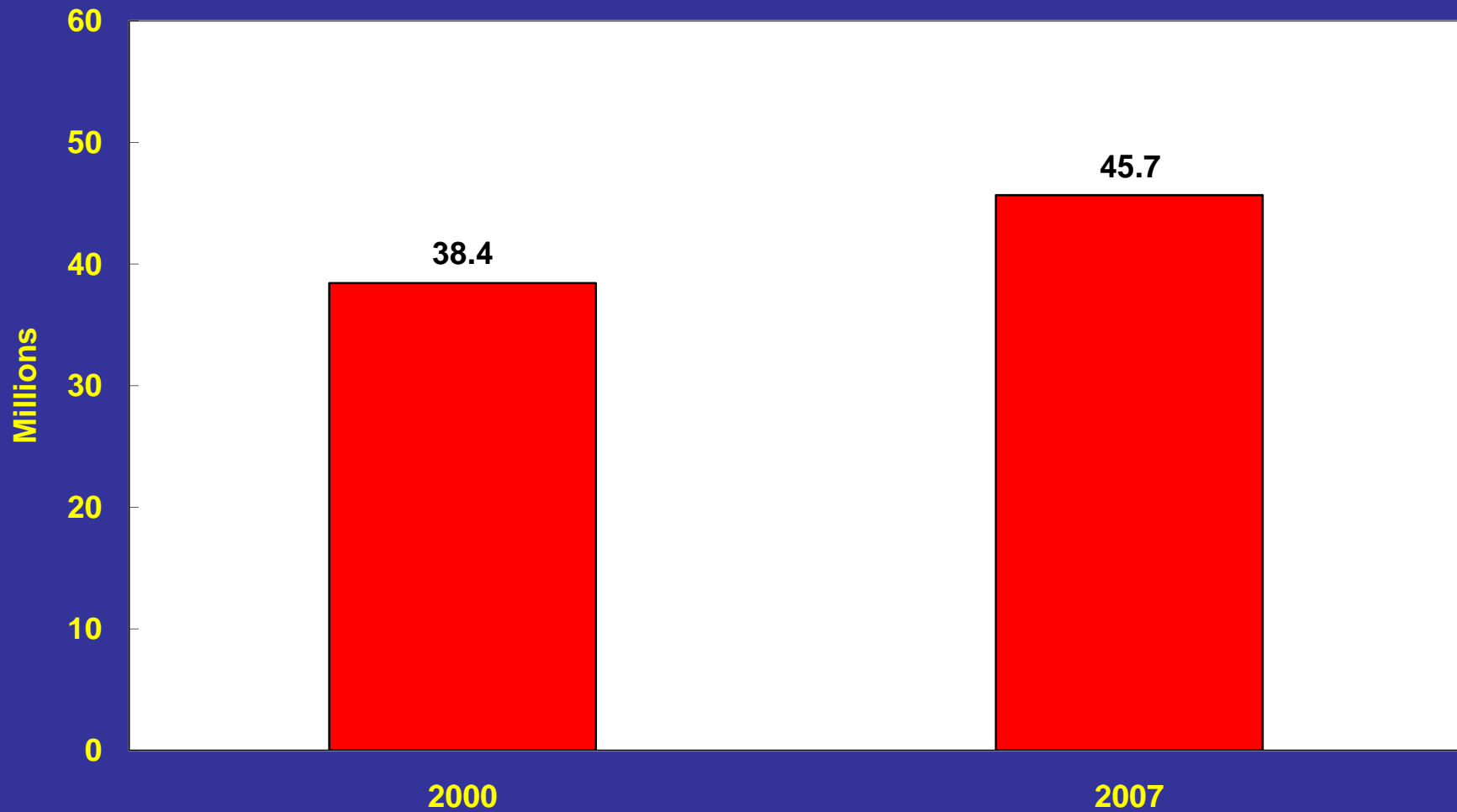
