News of the death of President KENNEDY was noted on the Naval net on 23 November. Operator chatter messages were noted, which asked for details of the assassination. The only details mentioned were that "Yesterday in Dallas he was shot by a sniper with a large calibre (rifle) [REDACTED]. Mortally wounded JOHN KENNEDY has died."

In the [REDACTED] area has been observed in CONINT [REDACTED] this reporting period. In addition to the [REDACTED] EXEMPT [REDACTED] be participating in this operation, the deployment of [REDACTED] EXEMPT troops to the area indicates an increased operational effort. (2/EXEMPT 55-63 and 2/Y EXEMPT 113-63).

Several references to a [REDACTED] operation utilizing the combined efforts of the [REDACTED] EXEMPT

[REDACTED] were contained in messages from [REDACTED] on 23 November. This operation was effected [REDACTED] in order to apprehend persons attempting to flee the country. (2/SI EXEMPT 1293-63).

There were also several messages about an operation in the [REDACTED] EXEMPT area of [REDACTED] Province. An insurgent band consisting of three individuals was captured at [REDACTED] EXEMPT [REDACTED] in the Municipality of [REDACTED] EXEMPT. Members of [REDACTED] EXEMPT were apparently utilized for this operation. (2/SI EXEMPT 1286-63, 2/Y EXEMPT 1292-63).

PART III-B - CRIMINAL INFORMATION

on 26 November 1963. The [REDACTED] ran aground while
entering the port of Mariel, sustaining uncontrollable leaks.
Soviet vessels sent to the scene included the [REDACTED]

A Cuban submarine named the IRIAC 3010 was forced by possibility
to put into the port of Santa Clara on 26 November 1963. Four persons
aboard the vessel were reported to have taken supplies at the base
in reliable sources. One source states that 15 persons remained at the
base and four others returned with the IRIAC 3010. The vessel was
