The Shwemann Sayadaw said he was about to set to work and that on a (B val holy day) in the month of Tabaung^C he would deliver a sermon which would deal with [XM] the danger of communism and how it seeks to thwart religion. He said he would also speak on how the Revolutionary Government [3G] (B val misrules) the people and how, once the people have been alerted, the government will be destroyed.

The monk continued by saying that as it has been with the monks who unhesitatingly bended together and put a stop to the trouble over the four pagoda colonnades and the (B val number) 45 petrol station, the people likewise will be able to put an end to their troubles. And today, as it has been with world leaders like NGO DINH DIEM and KENNEDY, Bogyoke NE WIN likewise will tremble with fear.
