Dear Mr. Corbin:

On February 7, 2008 Chugach Electric Association, Inc. (“Chugach”) submitted for filing Comments on Motion and Settlement Agreement Between Applicants and State of Alaska in the above referenced docket.

Upon review of the Table 1 a small error, immaterial to Chugach’s Comments, was noted. The production data for certain fields (not the fields that Chugach mentioned in its comments) were slightly affected by the inclusion of small volumes of gas removed from storage, in addition to volumes of produced gas. The attached replacement Table 1 corrects this error, which, again, is immaterial to Chugach’s comments. Enclosed please find an original and five copies of replacement Table 1. 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
