We would like to express our concerns and opposition to the blanket extension of the authorization for exporting Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) for another two years. South-Central Alaska is experiencing a severe shortage of natural gas, and natural gas prices for businesses and private residents have increased sharply to the extent of creating severe hardships. An authorization for exporting this resource will not help but most likely worsen this situation. Additional exploration may be incidental but should not be a consideration for this decision. Again, we would therefore like to express our opposition to the application for exporting LNG under FE Docket 07-02-LNG.
