ENSTAR Natural Gas Company (“ENSTAR”) has submitted two pleadings—on May 8 and May 19, 2008—in which ENSTAR has explained that its failure to file and serve its April 10 letter in accordance with the Department of Energy’s (“DOE”) regulations was a regrettable but unintentional error. Despite ENSTAR’s unequivocal statements to the contrary, Chugach Electric Association, Inc. (“Chugach”) continues to assert in the response referenced above that ENSTAR is either lying or attempting to mislead the DOE.

ENSTAR has provided the DOE with complete and truthful accountings regarding the April 10 letter in its May 8 and May 19 submissions. ENSTAR has nothing further to say on this matter. Accordingly, ENSTAR will not reply to Chugach’s response.¹
