Sign up to get your "Wild On Washington" Vehicle License Plate!



If I sign the signature sheet, am I legally obligated to purchase a Wild on Washington license plate? The petitions are not legally binding, but provide a method for contacting you with following up information, when (and if) the plates become available.

What, exactly, is a Wild On Washington license plate? It is a specialized license plate, featuring the majestic bald eagle and a glorious Washington sunset, with the "WW" designation, for "Wild on Washington." It is a great way to add color and beauty to your car, truck or motorcycle.

Is this in addition to the Mount Rainier background? No, it is an alternative.

When will it be available? If adopted by the Special License Plate Review Board and the 2005 Washington Legislature, Wild on Washington license plates would go on sale January 1, 2006.

How much will it cost? For the first year, the fee is \$40 plus any additional license plate expenses. For renewals, the fee drops to \$30.

The term "wildlife viewing activities" includes but is not limited to:

- Initiating partnerships with communities to jointly develop watchable wildlife projects
- Building infrastructure to serve wildlife viewers
- Assisting and training communities in conducting wildlife watching events
- Developing destination wildlife viewing corridors and trails,
