At the end, add the following:

4       (a) TITLE I AND IDEA FIRST.—None of the funds  
5 appropriated or otherwise made available pursuant to an  
6 authorization of appropriations or other provision of this  
7 Act (including an amendment made by this Act) shall be  
8 expended for any fiscal year unless—

9           (1) part A of title I of the Elementary and Sec-  
10       ondary Education Act of 1965 is fully funded for  
11       that fiscal year; and

12           (2) the Individuals with Disabilities Education  
13       Act is fully funded for that fiscal year.

14       (b) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this section:

15           (1) TITLE I.—Part A of title I of the Elemen-  
16       tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 shall be  
17       considered to be fully funded for a fiscal year only  
18       if the total amount appropriated or otherwise made

1 available for part A of such title for such fiscal year  
2 is at least \$25,000,000,000.

3 (2) IDEA.—The Individuals with Disabilities  
4 Education Act shall be considered to be fully funded  
5 for a fiscal year only if the total amount appro-  
6 priated pursuant to the authorization of appropria-  
7 tions under section 611(i) of such Act (20 U.S.C.  
8 1411(i)) or otherwise made available for that Act for  
9 such fiscal year is sufficient to provide the maximum  
10 grant to each State, as determined under section  
11 611(a)(2)(B) of such Act (20 U.S.C.  
12 1411(a)(2)(B)), for such fiscal year.
