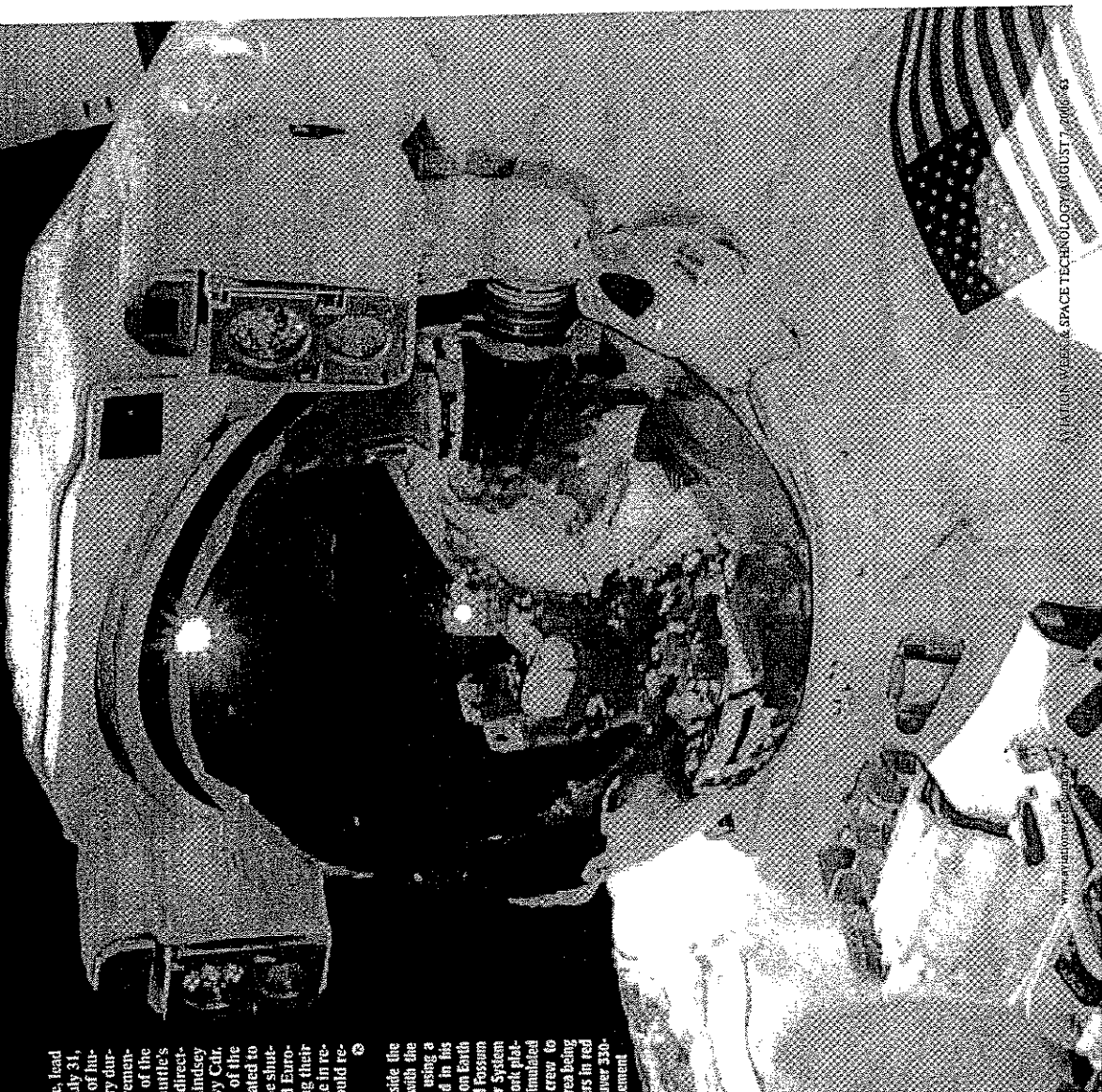
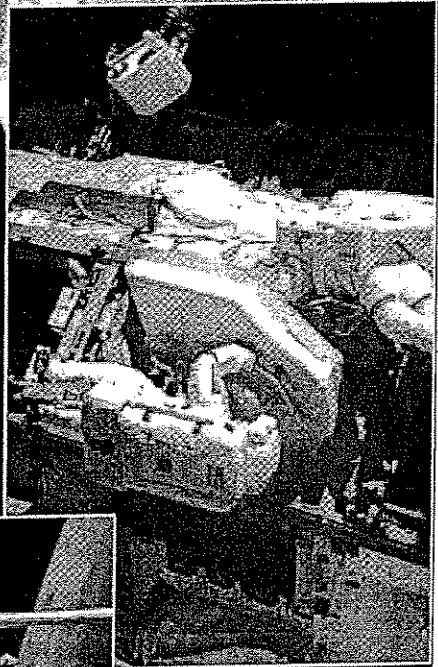
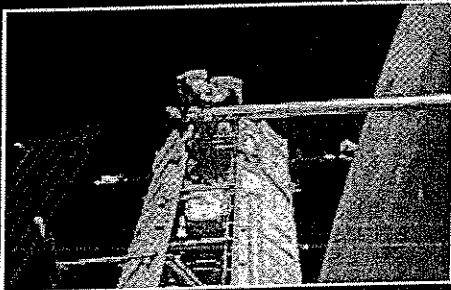
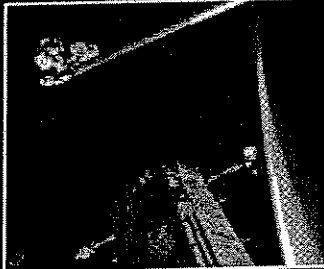
A TICKET TO FIX

After demonstrating ability to repair shuttle in orbit, NASA aims to service the Hubble Telescope one last time

The high achievements of the STS-121 Discovery mission will, barring future problems with the shuttle, lead to formal approval of a final space shuttle mission to service the Hubble Space Telescope (AW&ST July 31, p. 27). The powerful combination of robotics and extravehicular activity (EVA) along with the beauty of human space flight are highlighted in images here from both the International Space Station and Discovery during the mission at 220 mi. altitude. In addition to its technical achievements, the flight has given a tremendous moral boost to thousands of space workers across the country as they prepare for final assembly of the ISS and an increasingly likely Hubble flight about 2008. The mission proved modifications to the shuttle's external tank, repaired critical ISS assembly hardware and developed new orbiter autonomous repair capability directly related to the final Hubble servicing flight (AW&ST July 17, p. 54). STS-121 commander USAF Col. Steve Lindsey and copilot Navy Cdr. Mark Kelly led mission tasks involving intensive robotics operations by astronauts Navy Cdr. Lisa Nowak and Stephanie Wilson and three EVAs by Piers Sellers and USAF Col. (ret) Mike Fossum. Two of the EVAs, including demonstration of the Orbiter Boom Sensor System (OBSS) as a work platform, are directly related to an autonomous repair capability for any shuttle flight to Hubble where the ISS could not provide a safe haven. The shuttle crew was assisted by ISS Expedition 13 crewmen cosmonaut Pavel Vinogradov, Army Col. Jeff Williams and European Space Agency astronaut Thomas Reiter from Germany who transferred from Discovery to the ISS. During their third EVA, the crew used a Langley Research Center infrared camera to assess its ability to detect hidden damage in reinforced carbon-carbon wing leading edge material. Images of RCC samples (above left) showed the camera could reveal hidden subsurface damage (top cube) and characterize the crew's repair of sample damage (bottom cube).

Astronaut Piers Sellers works outside the Orbiter Discovery and ISS (right) with the Earth and crescent moon Mike Fossum, using a flash to take this picture, reflected in his visor. The delicate lighting of dawn on Earth 220 mi. below highlights Sellers and Fossum as they assess its suitability as a work platform. ISS port truss was used as a simulated orbiter structure (far left) for crew to demonstrate use of boom against area being repaired. Fossum, assisted by Sellers in red stripes (below), struggles to maneuver 330-lb. Trailing Umbilical System replacement unit critical to ISS mobile transporter system.

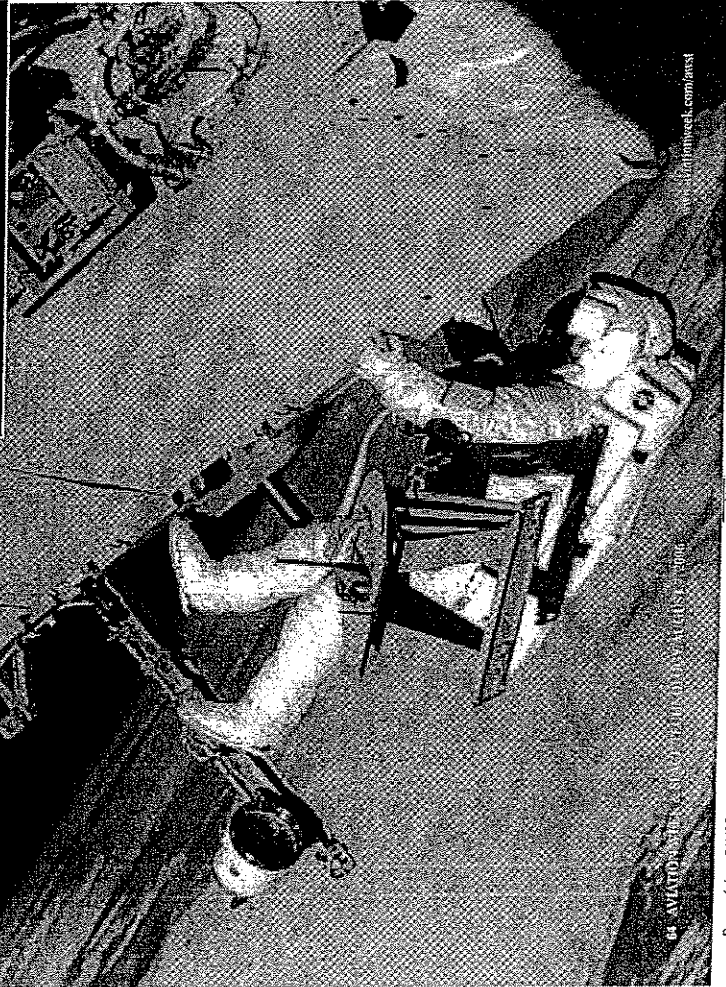
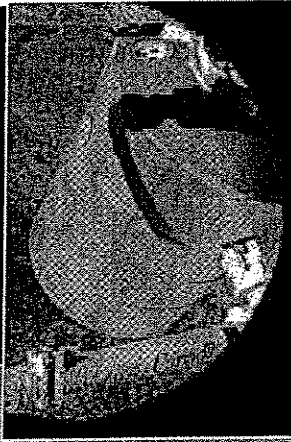
