- Medicare's new prescription drug benefit, which begins January 1, 2006, provides voluntary drug coverage for 43 million seniors and people with disabilities.
- The new Medicare prescription drug coverage pays for brand-name and generic drugs.
- People with limited income get extra help. Eligible citizens will be getting an application in the mail from the Social Security Administration.
- Specific information about drug coverage plans will be coming in October. You can join from November 15, 2005 - May 15, 2006. If you don't join by then you may have to pay a higher premium.
