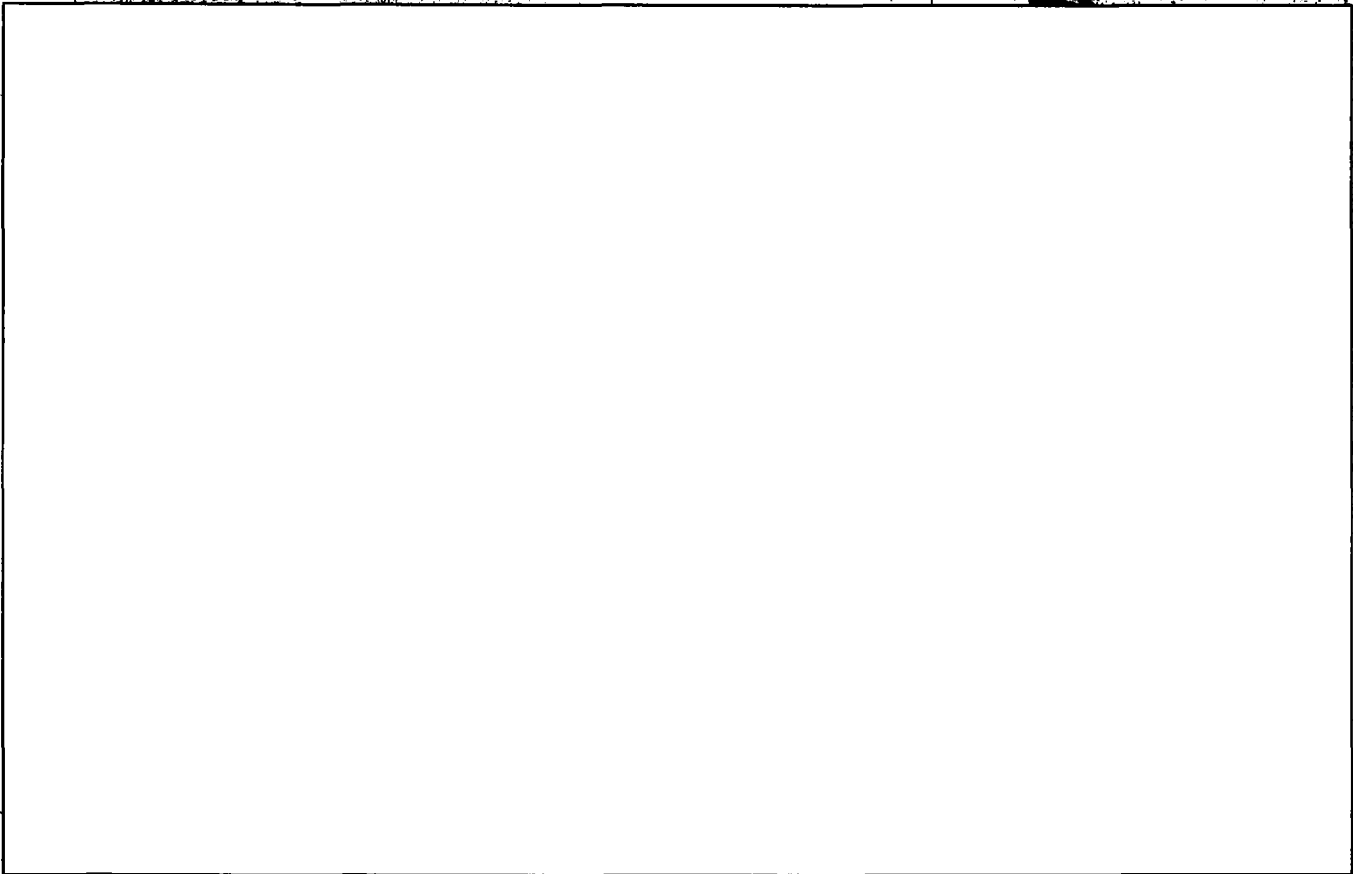

Sigint has, however, provided a complete depiction of the deployment of the NVA 325th Division. This activity commenced in late October/early November 1964, when Sigint reflected a splitting of the 325th Division Headquarters and the subsequent deployment of the bulk of the Division out of NVN via the Mu Gia Pass & down through Laos to the Western Highlands. The deployment of this Division was recognized entirely through traffic analysis, both cryptovisualization through M.C.F. and while cryptotyped by M.D.V. as being in Laos in late 1964, was later confirmed through collateral acquired in MACV, and represented the first large scale NVA commitment of an organic fighting unit in the war in the South.
