

5                   SALLY DEVIN: I am the public, and my  
6 name is Sally Devin, and I wear my tag so I know who  
7 I am and where I'm from. And we've been doing this  
8 for years. \*\*\*\*\*, Parumph, Nevada 89060.

9                   And I have been against Yucca Mountain  
10 since its very first meeting in January 4th, 1994,  
11 and we looked at that. And the reason is all of  
12 these years, and you have nothing to show for a  
13 billion dollars almost that you have spent, the \$18  
14 million dollars and the moneys that you get.

15                   And the reason is it's very good  
16 employment, it's very good public relations for our  
17 congress, and you are taught to do nothing, and  
18 that's exactly what you have done.

19                   Now, in welcoming us to Yucca Mountain --  
20 and I've been out there how many dozen of times, and  
21 I have explored the test site. I was with the  
22 University Group, and we went up to Paiute Mason. We  
23 all got a lethal dose. You remember that. And it  
24 was Earl Dixon and that whole bunch. Anyway, we had  
25 a wonderful time.

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1                   So I'm very familiar, not only with Yucca  
2 Mountain, but the test site. Now, the whole system  
3 is -- since this has been going, on the component, of  
4 course, is the canister. There isn't a sign of a  
5 canister, there has never been a canister, there will  
6 never be a canister.

7                   Because for anything to contain the  
8 waste, the rods, you would have to test it for ten  
9 years without the rods, with the rods, in the tunnel,  
10 and so on and so forth. Even if it was outside the  
11 tunnel or inside the tunnel, this has never been  
12 done. So that is four years of fraud right there.  
13 That is number one.

14                   The second thing is the geographic and  
15 geological concepts of Yucca Mountain. And, of  
16 course, we who live here know that this is a very --  
17 I like to use the word erratic, because the people  
18 are, as well as the mountain. And it has earthquakes  
19 almost every day, and you can get those reports off  
20 the Internet.

21                   And they're not big earthquakes. They're  
22 4.2, 5.2, and 4.7, 4.3, but they're there, and this  
23 is by Yucca Mountain. They have had major  
24 earthquakes. They also have major floods. So  
25 geographically, it is an impossible site.

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1                   So, anyway, it is still fun to study it,  
2 because it's going to change every day, and you can  
3 spend more money studying it. The surface facility  
4 as far as digging the tunnel -- and, of course, we  
5 had friends who dug the tunnel. And what was  
6 interesting about that was, of course, the water.  
7 And, of course, it is a leaky faucet, because it is  
8 full of springs. It is full of fractures, it is full  
9 of fissures, and all kinds of good stuff.

10                   So it is not only not feasible, but no  
11 concrete could last. They have tested this and so  
12 on. So they have no canister, they've got no plans  
13 for a tunnel, they've got no plans for storage, and  
14 it's in a leaky faucet mountain.

15                   So, as always, I will say in my comment,  
16 Stop this fraud. The \$18 billion that we rate payers  
17 have put into the fund should be used for health,  
18 welfare, old folks like myself, and students.  
19 Because in the -- this project, it is just pure  
20 fraud.
