ENHANCED SECURITY REQUIREMENTS FOR PORTABLE

GAUGES CONTAINING BYPRODUCT MATERIAL

The Commission has approved the staff's recommendation to publish in the <u>Federal Register</u> the proposed amendment to 10 CFR 30.34, subject to the changes noted below.

- In the <u>Federal Register</u> notice, the first two lines in the summary section should be modified to read "The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is proposing to amend its regulations in 10 CFR Part 30 governing the use of byproduct material in specifically licensed portable gauges. The proposed rule would require a portable gauge licensee to provide a minimum of..."
- 2. The proposed rule language on Page 20 on the FRN should be revised to read "Each portable gauge licensee shall use a minimum of two"
