



## Solving problems Installing or Uninstalling Internet Explorer 4.0

### Can you uninstall Internet Explorer 4.0 using the Add/Remove Programs Control Panel?

#### Note

- You must have administrative privileges to install and uninstall this program in Windows NT. This includes administrative privileges the first time you start your computer after installing or uninstalling.

#### To uninstall Internet Explorer 4.0 in Windows 95 and Windows NT 4.0

- Click **Start**, point to **Settings**, click **Control Panel**, and then double-click **Add/Remove Programs**.
- Click the **Install/Uninstall** tab.
- In the list of installed programs, click **Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0**, and then click **Add/Remove**.
- In the **Add/Remove Internet Explorer 4.0** dialog box, click **Remove Internet Explorer 4.0** and the components selected below and click to select all the additional components you want to remove. If you have selected all the components you want to remove, click **OK**.
- When Setup starts, click **Remove All**.

If you have any files in the Recycle Bin, you receive the following warning:

Internet Explorer 4.0 has modified the format of the Recycle Bin.  
 If you want to keep any of the items currently in the Recycle Bin, open the Recycle Bin and move the items to a different location.  
 To permanently delete all items from the Recycle Bin and continue, click OK.

- Click **OK** when you are sure there are no files in the Recycle Bin that you want to restore. You may also receive the following messages:

*Program* has been removed from this computer. Do you want to clean up your personal settings for this program.

where *Program* is Outlook Express, FrontPad, or Internet Explorer 4.0. If you are planning to reinstall a later version of Internet Explorer 4.0, click No. Otherwise, click Yes.

You can now install a later build of Internet Explorer 4.0. To restore a working installation of Internet Explorer version 3.02, you must remove extra files associated with Internet Explorer 4.0.

#### To remove remaining files associated with Internet Explorer 4.0



1. Complete the uninstall process listed above.
2. Click **Start**, point to **Find**, and then click **Files or Folders**.
3. Type a file name from the list below, and then click **Find Now**.
4. Right-click the file if it appears, and then click **Delete** to remove it.
5. Follow these steps for each of the following files:
  - o Inetcfg.dll
  - o Icw dial.dll
  - o Isign.dll
  - o Icwphbk.dll

These files are associated with the Internet Connection Wizard and are not removed during Internet Explorer 4.0 uninstallation.

6. Remove Internet Explorer 3.x using the Add/Remove Programs tool in Control Panel.
7. Reinstall Internet Explorer 3.02.
