Bob, Sun has been presenting things to us as fait accompli, do you really think that I could get Kannegaard to agree to cooperate with us on language extensions? And if he did, would we get everything we wanted? If there is no restriction in our contract that prevents us from innovating in the language, I want to come up with a complete list that makes it really easy to do ActiveX/VB-style programming with Java, hold a design review, and ship it.

I don't see how language innovation could drive Sun and Netscape closer together on the API front, and I assume that if we come up with great stuff, it will receive a positive reception from tools vendors and developers.

If Sun and we disagree on this and diverge in these areas, as long as Netscape doesn't buddy up with Sun, that is a super outcome for us (more fragmentation). But maybe you think Netscape would be forced to endorse and ship the Sun language variant?
