the plan of record as i understand it is that:

- we want oems to use our internet connection wizard (ICW) and reg server
- IMG will build co-branded start sites for users that come through the ICW
- we will work to build promotions with OEMs to make this a win win. laura is driving working with OEM on this. we need to do this b/c OEMs are working with ISPs on their own
- there are some exceptions on some of this for compaq, esp on the reg server
- there is an alternative plan on the table that we try to further improve the end user experience by letting OEMs pick their own ISPs. there are aol and other contract issues as well as business issues with this
- i think there other OEMs that want to replace our reg server, i don't know about this

given the external enviornment, there are some policy issues on how we do all of this that billg should weigh in on

We have an aggressive schedule to roll this first boot "windows experience" into a single presentation/set of policies and need your help.

Wed 3/4 Review with Account Management.
3/5 - 3/15 Executive (Bengt Akerlind) OEM briefings with key OEMs (IBM, CPQ, Dell, GW2K, HP, final list tbd)

Needs

- Rodney, Susan, Will - can you forward presentation content reviewing the features? Billv have we missed any groups?
- Autumn - can you take first cut at combining forwarded content into a single presentation as well as a review of any policy issues not covered by our existing first boot license provisions?
- Billv, Will, Susan, Yusuf - we may need your group representation in 3/2 - potentially 3/4 reviews.
- Will Poole - are you still involved in the revised business negots w/ the ISPs and if yes can you forward the general terms you offered? We anticipate that oems will raise several issues/concerns ranging from adding/deleting/ reprioritizing the ISP list to ensurng that their bounties with favored ISPs are still trackable, etc... a general review of the terms would be super helpful.
