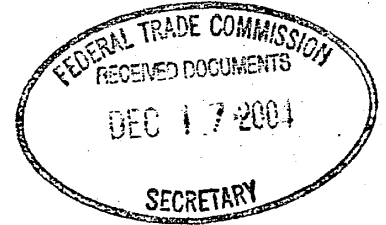

Dear Members of the Federal Trade Commission:

Now we read that you are considering loosening restrictions on telemarketers. Why?

We do not want more annoying phone calls. Answering those from SBC with which we have "*an established business relationship*" is already too many. Prerecorded messages from any company we pay with a credit card will be over the top.

We pay for our phone service and we want it used in a responsible manner--not for sales pitches.

Preseve the National Do Not Call Registry. Don't give in to the telemarketers.
