Internships are unpaid positions. During the summer months, internships generally last for a minimum of 5-6 weeks. During the academic year (September to May), internships generally cover the student's semester, from September to December in the Fall or January to May in the Spring. Both part-time and full-time internships are available.

Interns in our office must be highly motivated, have strong communication skills, both written and verbal, and a keen interest in the legislative process. Duties include attending legislative hearings and community meetings, participating in regular office meetings, conducting legislative research, giving tours of the Capitol Building to visiting Georgia District residents, and responding to constituent inquiries and phone calls.
