## **PROGRAM AND ENROLLMENT FACTS SHEET (MAJOR CHANGES FROM 6/30/2006 – 12/31/06)**

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- **Oregon** – The 1115(a) Expansion Enrollment decrease was due to a change in policy that did not accept new expansion enrollment.
- **Wisconsin** – The Managed Care Enrollment decrease was due to issues related to recertification of enrollees.
- **Mississippi** – There's no Medicaid Managed Care Enrollment as of 12/31/2006 due to the termination of the Disease Management Program.
