DEPOSIT ORIGINAL IN BOX - KEEP COPY IN YOUR POSSESSION

1. This permit is required for commercial and non-commercial boating on the Owyhee Wild and Scenic River.
2. The trip leader must have this permit in possession during the river visit and display it upon request by a BLM, State, or County Official . The trip leader is responsible for the conduct of the members of his/her party for the duration of the trip, including their compliance with area regulations and these conditions of use.
3. PARTY SIZE
Maximum party size is 15 persons above the Rome Launch Site and 20 persons below the Rome Launch Site. For commercial parties this includes all staff.
4. SANITATION
 - ◆ All solid human waste (fecal matter) must be carried out. All parties must be equipped with an approved carry-out system.
 - ◆ Urinate at least 100 feet from any camp area, on wet sand, or into the river.
 - ◆ Waste water must be thoroughly strained then deposited in the main flow of the river at least 200 feet from any spring or side stream.
5. FIRES AND FIREWORKS
Firepans to contain campfires are required. All ashes and other fire residue must be packed out. Only down and dead wood is to be burned. Pulling or cutting of brush or trees for any purpose is prohibited. Due to lack of natural firewood, it is recommended that float parties bring their own firewood. Possession and/or discharge of fireworks is prohibited.
6. GARBAGE
All garbage must be packed out, including food scraps, cigarette butts, dental floss, etc.
7. ARTIFACTS AND CULTURAL / HISTORIC SITES
Disturbing, removing, or damaging any historic structure, cultural feature, or artifact is prohibited. Enjoy these important features of the canyon, but leave them undisturbed for the future.
8. FIREARMS
Discharging a firearm near or within an occupied area, such as launch or take-out sites, in crowded areas, or near a campsite, is prohibited. Appropriate and safe use of firearms by all members of the party is the direct responsibility of the trip leader.
9. HOT SPRINGS
Hot springs contain delicate and rare ecosystems. Do not tamper with or in any way alter hot springs. Do not camp within 200 feet of any hot spring. Dragging and beaching watercraft in the vicinity of any hot spring is prohibited. When visiting hot springs, beach rafts well downstream.
10. CAMPSITES
Campsites may be closed for restoration due to overuse or vandalism. If a campsite is posted 'Closed' do not stop, and do not tamper with any sign. Camping at Rye Grass Camp and Greely Bar Camp is limited to one night.
11. AIRCRAFT LANDING
Landing of aircraft within the Wild and Scenic River Corridor is prohibited.
12. MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT
The use of any motorized equipment such as generators, scooters etc. is prohibited within the Wild and Scenic River Corridor.

1. This permit is required for commercial and non-commercial boating on the Owyhee Wild and Scenic River.
2. The trip leader must have this permit in possession during the river visit and display it upon request by a BLM, State, or County Official . The trip leader is responsible for the conduct of the members of his/her party for the duration of the trip, including their compliance with area regulations and these conditions of use.
3. PARTY SIZE
Maximum party size is 15 persons above the Rome Launch Site and 20 persons below the Rome Launch Site. For commercial parties this includes all staff.
4. SANITATION
 - ◆ All solid human waste (fecal matter) must be carried out. All parties must be equipped with an approved carry-out system.
 - ◆ Urinate at least 100 feet from any camp area, on wet sand, or into the river.
 - ◆ Waste water must be thoroughly strained then deposited in the main flow of the river at least 200 feet from any spring or side stream.
5. FIRES AND FIREWORKS
Firepans to contain campfires are required. All ashes and other fire residue must be packed out. Only down and dead wood is to be burned. Pulling or cutting of brush or trees for any purpose is prohibited. Due to lack of natural firewood, it is recommended that float parties bring their own firewood. Possession and/or discharge of fireworks is prohibited.
6. GARBAGE
All garbage must be packed out, including food scraps, cigarette butts, dental floss, etc.
7. ARTIFACTS AND CULTURAL / HISTORIC SITES
Disturbing, removing, or damaging any historic structure, cultural feature, or artifact is prohibited. Enjoy these important features of the canyon, but leave them undisturbed for the future.
8. FIREARMS
Discharging a firearm near or within an occupied area, such as launch or take-out sites, in crowded areas, or near a campsite, is prohibited. Appropriate and safe use of firearms by all members of the party is the direct responsibility of the trip leader.
9. HOT SPRINGS
Hot springs contain delicate and rare ecosystems. Do not tamper with or in any way alter hot springs. Do not camp within 200 feet of any hot spring. Dragging and beaching watercraft in the vicinity of any hot spring is prohibited. When visiting hot springs, beach rafts well downstream.
10. CAMPSITES
Campsites may be closed for restoration due to overuse or vandalism. If a campsite is posted 'Closed' do not stop, and do not tamper with any sign. Camping at Rye Grass Camp and Greely Bar Camp is limited to one night.
11. AIRCRAFT LANDING
Landing of aircraft within the Wild and Scenic River Corridor is prohibited.
12. MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT
The use of any motorized equipment such as generators, scooters etc. is prohibited within the Wild and Scenic River Corridor.
