Contact Information for Physicians and Non-Physician Practitioners Using the Internet-based Provider Enrollment, Chain and Ownership System (PECOS)

This document contains contact information concerning the operation of Internet-based PECOS.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has established an External User Services (EUS) Help Desk to assist physicians and non-physician practitioners if they encounter an application navigation or access problem with Internet-based PECOS. A navigation problem occurs when a practitioner is unable to determine how to use Internet-based PECOS. An access problem occurs when Internet-based PECOS is not operating properly (i.e., system is not operational, operating slowly, or a system-generated error message prevents data entry.) A system-generated messages does <u>not</u> include messages or warnings that are created when physicians or non-physician practitioners enter data incorrectly or ignore system prompts.

Note: CMS recommends that you change your NPPES password before accessing Internet-based PECOS for the first time and at least once a year thereafter. Although your NPPES User ID cannot be changed, you should periodically change your password – at least once a year.
