Submitted for your consideration is a request to make available \$569.6 million in previously appropriated emergency funds for the Department of Defense.

P.L. 105-277, the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act, 1999, provided \$1.5 billion in emergency funding for defense-wide operation and maintenance activities contingent upon the President submitting a budget request to the Congress and designating the entire amount requested as an emergency requirement. This amount, provided in Division B, Title 1, Chapter 1 of the Act, includes funding for national security activities. On December 21, 1998, you made available \$275 million for such activities. At this time, an additional \$569.6 million is needed to support a variety of national security programs. The purpose for which the \$569.6 million will be used is provided under separate classification.

I recommend that you designate the \$569.6 million as an emergency requirement in accordance with section 251(b)(2)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985, as amended. No further congressional action will be required.

I have carefully reviewed this proposal and am satisfied that it is necessary at this time. Therefore, I recommend that you make the requested funds available by signing the enclosed letter to the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
