## Food Stamp EBT Do's and Don'ts for Cashiers



- ☐ The customer *must* always present their EBT card.
- ☐ The customer must always enter their own PIN.
- □ Always give the customer the EBT receipt when the transaction is finished.
- □ Continue to accept paper food stamps for eligible purchases.

- □ Do not exchange cash for food stamp benefits (EBT).
- □ Do not accept food stamp benefits (EBT) as payment on credit accounts.
- □ Do not collect sales tax on items purchased with food stamp benefits.
- □ Do not set a minimum purchase amount *or* add a surcharge for using EBT.

## Penalties for Violation of the Food Stamp Program



## Penalties Include:

- Permanent disqualification when the owner or employees purchase or traffic in food stamp benefits, or for a third disqualification.
- ☐ Three to five year disqualification for the sale of non-food items, such as alcoholic beverages or tobacco.
- One to three year disqualification for accepting food stamp benefits for payment of credit accounts.
- □ Six month to three year disqualification for the sale of non-food items, such as, but not limited to: soap, paper products, medicines, etc.
