The American public is in for a big surprise. CBO's evaluation of the President's budget shows the President is proposing a \$557 billion tax increase in the form of a health tax proposal. This tax plan would undermine employer-provided health care, while doing little to expand coverage to those most in need.

RE-ESTIMATE OF BUSH FY 2008 BUDGET

CBO's re-estimate shows the President's budget is still in deficit in 2012, although by a relatively small amount.
