STATEMENT BY SENATE BUDGET COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN KENT CONRAD (D-ND) ON APPOINTMENT OF DOUGLAS W. ELMENDORF TO BE NEW CBO DIRECTOR

"I am very pleased that Douglas Elmendorf is the new Director of the Congressional Budget Office (CBO). Last month, I joined House Budget Committee Chairman Spratt in recommending Dr. Elmendorf to serve as Director of the non-partisan CBO. Dr. Elmendorf is one of our nation's leading economists. He will bring a wealth of knowledge and experience to this post. He has served with distinction throughout the federal government, working at the Federal Reserve, the Department of Treasury, the Council of Economic Advisers, as well as an earlier posting to the CBO. Dr. Elmendorf's research and writings about our nation's fiscal policy are extensive and well-regarded by economists and political leaders across the political spectrum.
