Page 25, strike lines 6 through 12 (paragraph (4) of section 1226(c)) and insert the following:

8 (4) The website shall provide detailed data on 9 funds obligated and contracts awarded by Federal, 10 State, or local agencies for purposes of carrying out 11 this Act, including information about the competi-12 tiveness of the contracting process, notification of 13 solicitations for contracts to be awarded, contractor 14 and subcontractor recipients of funds (including any 15 recipients that are minority, disadvantaged, or vet-16 eran-owned businesses) and information about the 17 process that was used for award of contracts.

Page 25, strike lines 13 through 15 (paragraph (5) of section 1226(c)) and insert the following:
