## To H.R. 1429

Page 34, after line 21, insert the following (and make such technical and conforming changes as may be appropriate):

(d) Transportation Safety.—

(1) Regulations.—The Secretary shall issue regulations establishing requirements for the safety features, and the safe operation, of vehicles used by Head Start agencies to transport children participating in Head Start programs.

(2) Good cause waiver authority.—The Secretary shall allow Head Start agencies to annually request a good cause exception to the requirements of regulations promulgated under paragraph (1) for one or more vehicles used by the agency or its designee in transporting children enrolled in a Head Start program or an Early Head Start program if--—

1	(A) such requirements would create a safe-
2	ty hazard in the circumstances faced by such
3	agency; or
4	(B) such requirements pertain to child re-
5	straint systems (45 C.F.R. 1310.11,
6	1310.15(a)) or bus monitors ( 45 C.F.R.
7	1310.15(e));
8	(C) the agency demonstrates that compli-
9	ance with such requirements will result in a sig-
10	nificant disruption to the Head Start program
11	or the Early Head Start program; and
12	(D) the waiver is in the best interest of the
13	children involved.
