

AMENDMENT
OFFERED BY MR. KILDEE OF MICHIGAN TO THE
AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUB-
STITUTE TO H.R. 2857

In section 1605, add at the end the following:

1 (7) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(1) STATE PLAN FOR BABY BOOMER AND OLDER
3 ADULT VOLUNTEER AND PAID SERVICE.—

4 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other
5 provision of this section, to be eligible to receive a
6 grant or allotment under subtitle B or C or to re-
7 ceive a distribution of approved national service posi-
8 tions under subtitle C, a State must work with ap-
9 propriate State agencies and private entities to de-
10 velop a comprehensive State plan for volunteer and
11 paid service by members of the Baby Boom genera-
12 tion and older adults.

13 “(2) MATTERS INCLUDED.—The State plan
14 shall include—

15 “(A) recommendations for public policy ini-
16 tiatives, including how to best tap the popu-
17 lation of members the Baby Boom generation

1 and older adults as sources of social capital and
2 as ways to address community needs;

3 “(B) recommendations to the State unit on
4 aging on—

5 “(i) a marketing outreach plan to
6 businesses;

7 “(ii) outreach to non-profit-organiza-
8 tions;

9 “(iii) the State’s Department of Edu-
10 cation; and

11 “(iv) other State agencies;

12 “(C) recommendations for civic engage-
13 ment and multigenerational activities, such
14 as—

15 “(i) early childhood education, family
16 literacy, and after school programs;

17 “(ii) respite services for older adults
18 and caregivers; and

19 “(iii) transitions for members of the
20 Baby Boom generation and older adults to
21 purposeful work in their post career lives.

22 “(3) KNOWLEDGE INCORPORATED.—The State
23 plan shall incorporate the current knowledge base
24 regarding—

1 “(A) the economic impact of older workers’
2 roles in the economy;

3 “(B) the social impact of older workers’
4 roles in the community; and

5 “(C) the health and social benefits of ac-
6 tive engagement for members of the Baby
7 Boom generation and older adults.

8 “(4) PUBLICATION.—The State plan must be
9 made public and be transmitted to the Chief Execu-
10 tive Officer.”.
