Dear Senator Lugar:

On behalf of Saint Mary's College, I am writing to request federal appropriations for four projects that are among the College's top priorities for FY2009. These projects will improve our infrastructure, support community education initiatives, and provide economic opportunities to women-owned businesses.

Our FY2009 appropriations requests are as follows, in priority order:

- 1) Saint Mary's College O'Laughlin Auditorium and Little Theatre for Critical Infrastructure Renovations, \$500,000, Department of Housing and Urban Development; Economic Development Account
- 2) Saint Mary's College Nursing Laboratory Improvements, \$1.25 million, Department of Energy; Science Account
- 3) Expansion of the Saint Mary's College Tutoring and Mentoring Project for At-Risk Youth, \$600,000, Department of Education; Fund for the Improvement of Education Account
- 4) Saint Mary's College Program for Women's Entrepreneurship, \$600,000, Small Business Administration; Salaries and Expense Account
