- 1) **H.R. 1068** - To amend the High-Performance Computing Act of 1991 (*Reps. Baird, Biggert – Science and Technology*)
- 2) **H.R.1126** - To reauthorize the Steel and Aluminum Energy Conservation and Technology Competitiveness Act of 1988 (*Reps. Lipinski, Ehlers – Science and Technology*)
- 3) **H.R. 85** - Energy Technology Transfer Act (*Rep. Biggert – Science and Technology*)
- 4) **H.Res.136** - Commending the Girl Scouts of the United States of America on the occasion of their 95th anniversary, for providing quality age-appropriate experiences that prepare girls to become the leaders of tomorrow and for raising issues important to girls (*Rep. McCarthy – Oversight and Government Reform*)
- 5) **H.Res.89** – Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that a day should be established as Dutch-American Friendship Day to celebrate the historic ties of the United States and the Netherlands (*Rep. Hoekstra – Oversight and Government Reform*)
