

Driving Directions
Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center Campus
NIDA/NIH 251 Bayview Blvd., Baltimore, MD 21224

From Points South (Including BWI Airport):

- Take I-295 north to the Harbor Tunnel Thruway (I-895). (Can also take I-95 to I-895)
- After exiting the tunnel, proceed to exit 12 (Lombard Street).
- After taking the exit, turn right at the first traffic light.
- Go past a walkway and through a stop sign.
- Turn at the next left onto Hopkins Bayview Circle.
- Turn left into the parking lot.

-or-

- Take I-95 through the Fort McHenry Tunnel to exit 59 (Eastern Avenue).
- Turn left onto Eastern Avenue and proceed approximately one mile to Bayview Boulevard on the right.
- Turn right onto Bayview Boulevard.
- Follow through one traffic light and at the stop sign make a right onto Hopkins Bayview Circle.
- Turn left into the parking lot.

From Points North and East:

- Take I-95 south to exit 59 (Eastern Avenue).
- Turn right (west) onto Eastern Avenue and proceed approximately one mile to Bayview Boulevard on the right.
- Turn right onto Bayview Boulevard.
- Follow through one traffic light and at the stop sign turn right onto Hopkins Bayview Circle.
- Turn left into the parking lot.

-or-

- Take I-895 south to exit 12 (Lombard Street).
- At the first light turn right onto Bayview Boulevard.
- Go past a walkway and a stop sign.
- Turn at the next left onto Hopkins Bayview Circle.
- Turn left into the parking lot.

From the parking lot, walk toward the sidewalk of Bayview Blvd. (This is the main road through the campus.) Do not cross Bayview Blvd. Turn right and follow the sidewalk towards Lombard St. (away from Eastern Ave). You will cross Nathan Shock Drive and pass a light tan building on the right. The NIDA building is the next one on the right up on a hill. The recruiting entrance (labeled Clinical Entrance on the map) is NOT at the front of the building. There is a blacktop walkway that goes off to the left (from the main entrance) through large white rocks. Follow the walkway around the hill and around the side of the building. Come into the third door on the right hand side (a parking lot will be on your left). Security will be there. Please let them know you have an appointment with recruiting and they will direct you to the reception area. A map of the campus is enclosed for you as well.

#10 Bus:

The #10 bus runs from Sparrows Point/Dundalk/State Center and stops at the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center campus on Eastern Avenue in front of the hospital. If you are coming on an eastbound bus, you will have to cross Eastern Avenue to get to Bayview Boulevard. If you are coming on a westbound bus, you will be on the same side of the street as Bayview Boulevard. Walking up Bayview Boulevard from Eastern Avenue, you will go through one traffic light, through one stop sign, and past a crosswalk. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd. on the right side.

#20 Bus:

The #20 bus runs from Dundalk/Dundalk Community College/Dundalk Marine Tunnel to Downtown and stops near the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center campus on the corners of Eastern Avenue and Ponca Street. Walk two blocks east on Eastern Avenue toward the hospital. Turn left on Bayview Boulevard. Walk up Bayview Boulevard and go through one traffic light, through one stop sign, and past a crosswalk. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd. on the right side.

#22 Bus:

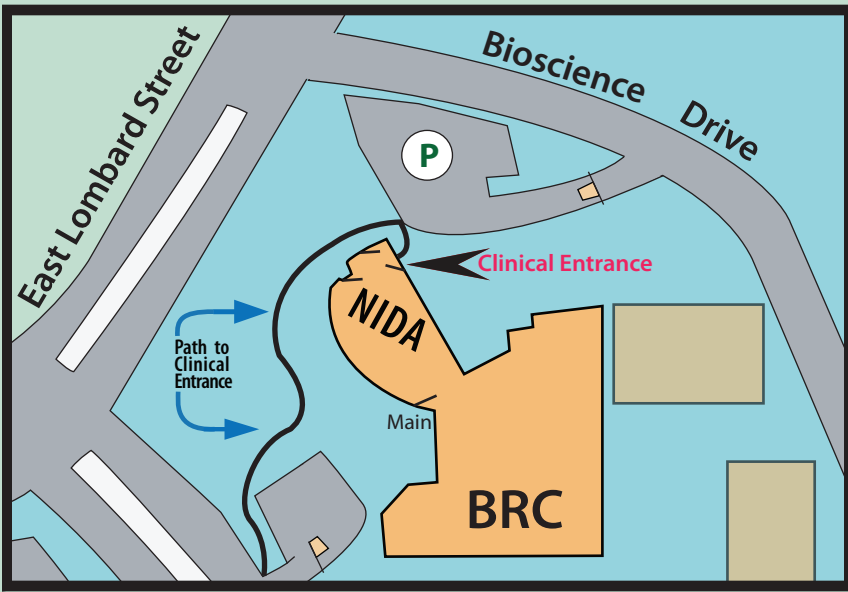
The #22 runs from Curtis & Spruce/Mondawmin Metro Station to Highlandtown/Bayview Medical Center. Route 22 ends at the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center campus and drops you off at the emergency room. Walk west on Nathan Shock Drive. Turn right on Bayview Blvd. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd. on the right side.

#23 (East) Bus:

The #23 (East) bus runs from Middle River/Fox Ridge/Essex/Victory Villa to Wilson Point and stops at the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center campus on Eastern Avenue in front of the hospital. If you are coming on an eastbound bus, you will have to cross Eastern Avenue to get to Bayview Boulevard. If you are coming on a westbound bus, you will be on the same side of the street as Bayview Boulevard. Walking up Bayview Boulevard from Eastern Avenue, you will go through one traffic light, through one stop sign, and past a crosswalk. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd. on the right side.

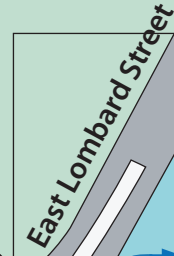
The NIDA building is the last one at the end of Bayview Blvd. up on a hill. The recruiting entrance (labeled Clinical Entrance on the map) is NOT at the front of the building. There is a blacktop walkway that goes off to the left (from the main entrance) through large white rocks. Follow the walkway around the hill and around the side of the building. Come into the third door on the right-hand side (a parking lot will be on your left). Security will be there.
