Contract Audit Training Working Group

In response to requests from President Counsel on Integrity and Efficiency (PCIE) and Executive Counsel on Integrity and Efficiency (ECIE) member Office of Inspector's General, the FAEC Contracting Committee recommends the following course sequence to provide contract specific training for previously qualified auditors (GS/YA-0511 Series) assigned to contract audit functions.
