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## Summertime



Who is caring for your child?

Find out about the rules for Health,

Safety, Staff, And More for the Summer Experience you choose for your child. Different Programs, like \*day camps, \*over-night camps, \*licensed child care, \*summer playgrounds have different requirements that you should know about before you make a summer decision.

## Questions to Ask when choosing Summer Programs:

Is the Program licensed and/or accredited? By whom?

How long has this Program been in operation?

Does the Program have any organizational affiliations? (professional, religious, government, social)

Who will be supervising my child and how old are they?

How many children are assigned to a group?

How many children are assigned to one staff member?

Is staff trained in CPR and First Aid?

What other training is required of staff?

Is staff required to have background checks?

What is the discipline policy? (ask for a copy)

What if my child needs to take medication?

In the event of an emergency, what is your plan?

Do you take fieldtrips?

How do you transport children?

## Look at Indoor Space-

Is it clean, safe and well equipped for groups of children? Are bathrooms clean? How is food prepared or stored?

## Look at Outdoor Space-

Is the play area fenced or protected by natural barriers? Is play equipment in good repair? Are areas under play equipment covered by safe surfaces? How is the area supervised when children are outdoors?
