Recently you participated in a voluntary screening exam as part of the Lung Screening Study. The result of your (CHEST X-RAY/SPIRAL CT) exam was found to be negative for lung cancer. However, a small lung growth was found. This type of abnormality is frequently detected on lung scans and is usually benign. Nevertheless, a screening exam is limited in its ability to provide a conclusive diagnosis, and at the present time, the significance of the growth that was observed on your exam cannot be determined. The attached report provides you with detailed results of your exam.

Because the significance of your finding is unknown, we suggest that you speak with your physician regarding the findings of your screening exam. A copy of the exam results has been mailed to your physician if you listed one at the time you started in the study. If you do not have a physician or would like the name of another physician, please contact the Screening Center and our staff will assist you in locating one.

The screening examination was not intended to be a complete physical examination or a substitute for a visit to a doctor.
