08/01/2004. Reference page 7, Statement of Work - Part A of the RFP, Item 7, states the Phase I clinical trials must be completed within 30 months of award. For bidding purposes, is the total duration of the contract 2

years or 30 months?

**Answer 2:** 30 months

**Question 3:** Is there a way to obtain a list of companies that are interested in bidding on this effort?

**Answer 3:** Since the RFP is posted electronically, we do not have a way of maintaining a Bidders List and are not able to

assist in teaming arrangements.

## **Question 4:**

Under Milestone III there is a reference to animal models and a reference to Note 3. Note 3 makes a reference to small animal models. Since the RFP only refers to small animal models, does that mean the Government is not interested in non-human primates, which are not categorized as small animals? By the use of the word "models" the RFP implies that there is more than one small animal model in existence. Why is the word "model" plural?

## Answer 4:

Although we are not aware of small animal models other than the mouse model, we would consider any data with any model. We do not require more than one small animal model. We are not requiring primate data for this contract.
