Action Item 4: (Colleen) Check to see why you can no longer indicate the preferred address in the new Person module.

Michael Goodman, developer on the Persons Module, responded as follows:

Preferred address can never be un-checked. It can be checked when you're dealing with an address that is NOT currently the "preferred" one. This was all covered in the TARs that supported the July release of the Persons Module, and was meticulously explained in the Persons Release Notes. I can't say what actually got folded into the CM release notes, but I know I provided all this information to the doc group.

In other words, you can PREFER an address, but you can't just "unprefer" one. Think of it like the "set printer as default" option in your PC's control panel settings. The only way you can get one printer to STOP being the preference is by picking another one to take its place.

If people cannot "check" the preferred flag on an address that is NOT currently preferred, then this is another story. Such a situation DOES warrant further investigation. If you can send us a committee ID and person ID in that case, we should be able to check into it.

		Need to investigate the implications of this default throughout the system and how it affects, for example, vouchers.
8	6.4 IRG/SEP Post Mtg Roster Verification Screen	Colleen clarified that anything that is changed on this screen ripples through to change all associated modules.
		It was noted that this screen works for IRGs and SEPs but does not work for PAC, NAC and BSC.
	Save/Verify buttons	The Save button/option is for the SRA.
		The Roster Verify button/option is for the GTA.
	Attendee Class	Action: (Colleen) Prepare the business rule for changing "Attendee Class" to determine what needs to change. We'll determine Use Case, finalize business rules and determine what the changes will affect.
