First, let me thank the NIEHS for inviting public comment on replacing the LD-50 test with non-animal, in vitro testing methods.

Second, let me remark that I am *strongly* in favor of the NIEHS beginning efforts to completely replace lethal dose testing with non-animal, in vitro testing methods. The LD-50 test has always been both horribly wasteful of animal lives and a horrendously cruel method of testing for toxicity. It is an

outdated testing method which must be permanently discontinued. Please do all you can to phase out the LD-50 test and phase in a benign, humane, and scientifically more legitimate method. Thank you.
