
- Review Folder is an electronic collection of all documents a reviewer would normally receive in preparation for meeting, as prepared by SRA/GTA.

- Other document types are possible.






















CD Contents

Content Quality Problem

- Review Guidelines are not always available in time for CD production.
- ICs were supposed to provide a Web page of Review Guidelines for CD contractor to retrieve. Only three ICs have complied: CSR, NIDA, and NIDDK.
- Some SRAs have reported that a complete set of PA/RFAs is not always placed on the CD.
- Apparently PA/RFAs are not always reported on Grant Application, therefore IMPAC II data does not indicate need for PA/RFA. Also, perhaps it is possible that PA/RFA is sometimes not correctly recorded in IMPAC II.
- There are indications that some ICs maintain PA/RFAs outside the NIH Guide.


Review Policy Issues

- Reviewers should only receive approved Review Guidelines.
 - SRAs sometimes distribute unapproved or obsolete guides.
 - Additional sensitivity regarding human subjects.
- Reviewers should only receive approved PA and RFAs.
 - SRAs sometimes distribute PA/RFAs that are not currently in the NIH Guide.
 - The NIH Guide is the "approved" set of PA/RFAs.





Review Folder Concept

- Review Folder is an electronic collection of all documents a reviewer would normally receive in preparation for meeting. The SRA can edit the collection to assure it is accurate and complete.
- Review Folder allows only approved Review Guidelines and PA/RFAs. ICs will have flexibility to control and provide their own approved versions.
- Review Folder can be placed in IAR for online access by reviewers. This will set stage for eventual obsolescence of CDs.
- Review Folder can serve as a new interface to the CDs, providing SRAs and Reviewers with same UI no matter if CD or Internet.
