Roadmap Announcements

- Roadmap opportunities announced via announcement number beginning with the characters "RM". E.g. RM04-018
- Each Initiative may have one or more announcements. As a result, the title of an announcement may differ from the Initiative



Roadmap Receipt & PO Assignments

- A "virtual" IC called RM created for the NIH Roadmap
 - All Roadmap applications will have primary assignment to a lead IC and secondary to RM IC
 - May also have additional secondary assignment(s)
 - Lead IC will have standard lead PO assignment
 - The RM secondary IC will have a Project Team Lead assignment
 - Non-RM dual ICs: standard secondary assignment(s)
 - Within eRA/QVR systems, RM Project Team Lead assignment treated as a RM PO dual-assignment
 - That is, the RM Project Team Lead will appear as a RM PO in all screens, web pages, and reports

Roadmap PCC Assignments

- Lead IC and non-RM IC assignments will be made via an IC's PCC
- The RM secondary assignment will be made via <u>new</u> PCCs created for the RM IC
- Format of the RM IC PCC is as follows:
 - 1st character: Theme
 - 2nd and 3rd characters: Implementation Group
 - 4th character: Initiative
 - 5th & 6th characters: Sub-initiative (defined as RFA in IMPACII)

Roadmap Review and Council

- SEPs in CSR are reviewing some Roadmap applications, some being reviewed in SEPs established by review staff from the lead IC
- Project Team members responsible for helping the SRA with reviewer recommendations
- Only the lead and dual-interest IC will be taking Roadmap applications to council
 - RM IC will not have Council, but Project Team Lead from RM IC may attend council
- If funded with Roadmap funds, the lead IC PO will participate in award approval activities

Roadmap Funding

- Funding accomplished via unique set of CANs (policy may change in FY2005)
- Each IC assigned minimum of three CANs, for intramural & extramural grants, and contracts
- If not funded with Roadmap funds-
 - Secondary assignment means one or more ICs can consider funding the application with IC funds
 - If this occurs, project will take on the status of "Roadmap Affiliated"
 - Still tracked through Roadmap evaluation measures



Roadmap in eRA - Phases

- Implementation of Roadmap will be conducted in two phases
 - In Phase 1, modification required to process and award Roadmap applications will be implemented
 - Completed, except in PGM!
 - In Phase 2, the ability to query and report on Roadmap applications will be implemented via Web QT
 - QVR has also implemented Roadmap features



Internal to IMPACII

- RFA Announcements:
 - An "enterprise program code" added to denote a Roadmap RFA notice
- Funding/Grants Management:
 - An "enterprise program code" added to denote a Roadmap CAN
 - Each IC provided a minimum of three (3) new CANS for Extramural, Intramural/IRP, and Contracts funding
 - e-NGA modified to denote Roadmap and Roadmap Affiliated awards
 - Roadmap: THIS AWARD IS FUNDED AS AN NIH ROADMAP INITIATIVE
 - Roadmap Affiliated: THIS AWARD IS ISSUED IN RESPONSE TO AN NIH ROADMAP APPLICATION

PGM and Roadmap


- Roadmap PO from the lead administering IC
 - Grants assigned as any other in a portfolio
- Roadmap Project Team Leads from the RM IC
 - RM would act as a secondary IC
 - Grants assigned as a dual interest application:
 - Once logged in to My Portfolio in PGM, select the "Include Duals" checkbox and click the Search button
 - Using the IMPAC-II ICO module, change the default IC RM as the primary. Then re-log in to PGM.
- POs from any non-RM secondary ICs
 - Grants assigned as any non-RM secondary ICs as a dual interest application
 - Once logged in to My Portfolio in PGM, select the "Include Duals" checkbox and click the Search button





