# The Migration Game

## NORTH AMERICA

Ducks like Anna, and other migratory birds, must fly great distances from their northern nesting grounds to reach their winter homes in South America. In this game the players will pretend to be ducks migrating south on the Atlantic Flyway from Canada to South America. This is over 2000 miles. (Many birds fly even farther!) You will need a die, something to mark your place, (pebbles, buttons, pennies) and a crayon. Each player rolls the die and moves that number of spaces. Spaces marked 'NWR' are National Wildlife Refuges. If you pass over one, you may stop there to rest, without finishing the whole move. After you move your duck, color in a space on the game map. This represents habitat that is lost to development. If any duck lands on a colored space, that duck will lose the next turn. All birds need food and a place to rest before they can fly, and it is much harder to find them when habitat is destroyed. National Wildlife Refuges can never be developed, so ducks will always have a place to rest there. The first duck to reach South America wins!
