#### Risk factors

#### **Breast Cancer:**

Mammographic density
Postmenopausal estrogen levels
Premenopausal progesterone levels
Menopausal estrogen-progestin therapy

Need for thorough understanding of what we know about the disease to interpret results (e.g. aromatase and postmenopausal estrogen levels as they relate to disease)

How do births at a young age reduce breast cancer risk?

How do mammographic densities increase risk?

### **Biology**

#### **Ovarian Cancer:**

Oral contraceptives provide major lifelong protection Estrogen increases risk Progestin more than blocks the increase Progestin needs to be decreased to prevent breast cancer

Pharmacogenetic directed tx: OC types & dosing 100 million women took the Pill today Biomarkers absorption/spotting/clotting effect on ovarian cancer target cell effect on breast cancer target cell
