ACTING DIRECTOR NAMED FOR RMP SERVICE

The following is quoted from a memorandum dated March 16, 1970 from Dr. Joseph T. English, Administrator of the Health Services and Mental Health Administration:

"Dr. Stanley Olson has decided to return to private life and has announced his resignation as Director of the Regional Medical Programs Service. He has made a number of recommendations to me in order to provide for a smooth transition to new full-time leadership of the Regional Medical Programs Service and I have concurred in them. Among these are his request that he be relieved of responsibility of direct operations and that he serve in an advisory and consultant capacity until his departure June 1, 1970

"Accordingly, effective Tuesday, March 17, direction of the Regional Medical Programs Service will be assumed by the Office of the Administrator and I am designating Dr. Harold Margulies as Acting Director, Regional Medical Programs Service...

"Dr. Margulies has been serving with great distinction as Deputy Assistant Administrator for Program Planning and Evaluation since Sept. of 1969. Prior to this appointment he had been serving in the Washington Office of the American Medical Assn., where he was Secretary of the AMA Council on Health Manpower and was responsible for coordinating AMA activities with the Executive Branch of the Federal Government. From 1965 to 1967, Dr. Margulies was Associate Director of the Division of International Medical Education of the Association of American Medical Colleges. He has done consultant work with the National Advisory Commission on Health Manpower and has been a consultant with the White House Office of Science and Technology. He also was an Advisor on Medical Education to the World Health Organization.

"Dr. Margulies holds the degrees of A.B. (Philosophy, University of Minnesota, 1938); B.Sc. (Medicine, U of South Dakota, 1940); M.D. (U of Tennessee, 1942); and M.Sc. (Medicine, U of Minnesota Graduate School of Medicine, Mayo Foundation, 1948). He held a Fellowship in Internal Medicine at the Mayo Clinic in 1944-45 and from 1946-49."

CHEMOTHERAPISTS MEET

Major needs apparent to the group were the establishment of standards, and wider extension of awareness of chemotherapy potentials. The interest of the group in a continuing working structure and forum for cancer chemotherapists is to be explored further at a second meeting in the near future.
