★ SENIOR YEAR

➤ FALL Finalize information in your Congressional file and mail by deadline.

- ✓ Notifications of early offers of admission/appointment and Letters of Assurance are sent to both applicants and Members of Congress by Academies

➤ WINTER From qualified applicants, slates of ten nominees per vacancy are chosen and nominated to each academy.

➤ SPRING Qualified nominees are offered Appointments to Academies based on available vacancies.

➤ SUMMER Newly appointed classes enter Academies
