3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Tailpipe Pollution

5 Standards Act".

6 SEC. 2. WAIVERS OF PREEMPTION.

7 Section 209 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7543)

8 is amended by adding at the end the following:

1	"(f) WAIVERS OF PREEMPTION.—
---	------------------------------

2	"(1) Pending requests.—Not later than 30
3	days after the date of enactment of this subsection,
4	but in no case later than September 30, 2007, the
5	Administrator shall issue to the Governor of each
6	applicable State a decision on each request for a
7	waiver of preemption under subsection (b) that—
8	"(A) has been submitted by the State; and
9	"(B) is pending as of the date of enact-
10	ment of this subsection.
11	"(2) SUBSEQUENT REQUESTS.—With respect to
12	a request for a waiver of preemption under sub-
13	section (b) (including such a request submitted by a
14	State that has adopted and enforced certain stand-
15	ards as described in section 177) that is submitted
16	by a State after the date of enactment of this sub-
17	section, not later than 180 days after the date on
18	which the Administrator receives the request, the
19	Administrator shall issue to the Governor of the
20	State a decision on whether to grant the waiver.".
