**POSITION:** Program Coordinator - Feed and Environmental Water Laboratory

LOCATION: UGA Agricultural and Environmental Services Laboratories, Athens, Georgia

**SALARY:** Salary is commensurate with experience and training.

**BASIC QUALIFICATIONS**: Ph.D. in Soil, Environmental, or Biological Sciences required with a strong laboratory background. Training and/or experience in water quality and forage analysis desirable. Ability to conduct and interpret research; good verbal, written, and computer skills required.

**MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES**: The successful candidate will manage the programs, staff and budgets associated with a laboratory that primarily conducts analyses of feed and environmental water samples submitted to the laboratory. The following are major responsibilities inherent to the position:

- Hires, trains and supervises office and laboratory staff.
- Selects, develops and adapts appropriate analytical procedures for testing feedstuffs and waters.
- Ensures that the laboratory is operated safely with appropriate quality assurance and control.
- Coordinates with faculty the interpretations and recommendations based on laboratory results.
- Conducts workshops and training for County Extension staff and faculty on pertinent laboratory functions.
- Collaborates with County Extension Agents, other faculty and agencies in diagnostic, educational and research projects.
- Seeks external funding through grant-in-aid to support relevant research and extension projects.
- Conducts promotional efforts to expand public awareness of programs and services of the laboratory.
- Serves as a member of the Agricultural and Environmental Services Laboratories leadership team.
