The Interdisciplinary Science and Technology Building III

The 34,600-square-foot facility is home to research in Applied Biological Sciences, Applied Psychology, Healthy Lifestyles, and Plant Made Pharmaceuticals.

The Agribusiness Center

Offers a Market Information/Trading Room, a Consumer Behavior Research Lab, and a Pre-Veterinary Medicine Testing Theater, along with the PING Swing Analysis Lab. The Consumer Behavior Research Lab is available for use by ASU's industry partners. For more information call (480) 727-1585.

DRIVING TO ASU POLYTECHNIC CAMPUS

From Tempe campus

Drive south on Rural Road and take the Superstition Freeway (US 60) heading east toward Mesa and Apache Junction. Exit the Superstition Freeway at Power Road. Take Power Road south to Williams Field Road. Turn left (east) onto Williams Field Road and follow the signs that label ASU's Polytechnic campus buildings.

From Sky Harbor Airport

All major airlines fly into Sky Harbor International Airport in Phoenix. Take State Route 143 south and exit onto Interstate 10 heading east. Take I-10 and exit onto the Superstition Freeway (US 60) heading east toward Mesa and Apache Junction.

Exit the Superstition Freeway at Power Road. Take Power Road south to Williams Field Road. Turn left (east) onto Williams Field Road and follow the signs that label ASU's Polytechnic campus buildings.

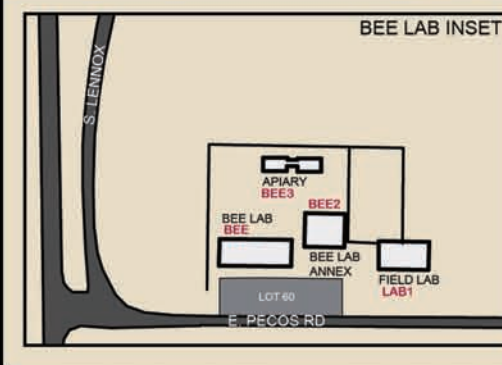
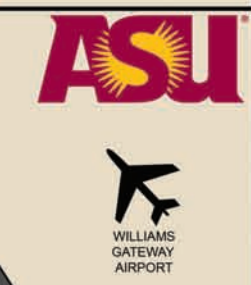
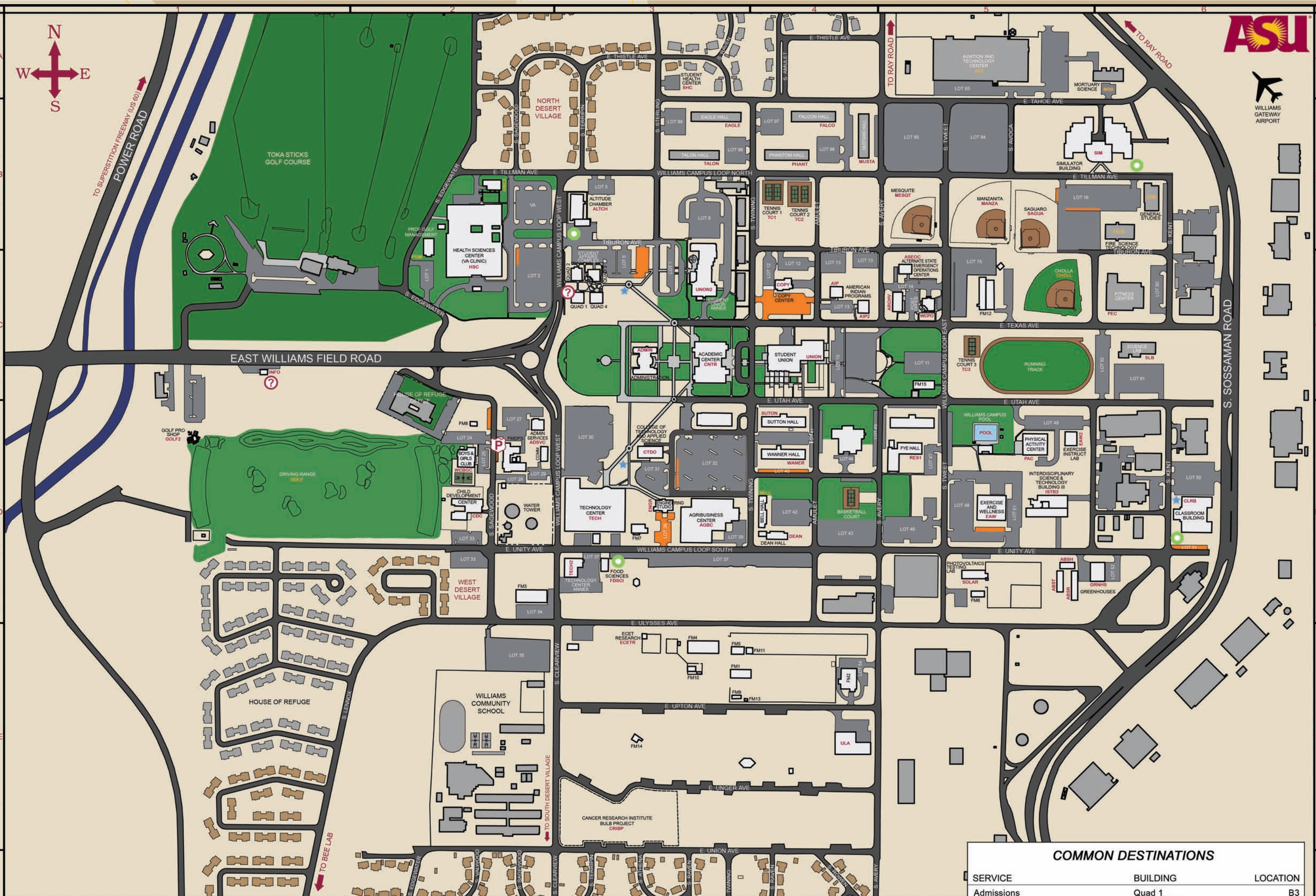

Courses were first offered at the campus in Fall 1996. As a polytechnic-focused campus, the emphasis is on professional and technical programs that prepare graduates to move directly into careers and become ethical leaders in their professional, public and personal lives.

Students can earn ASU bachelor's, master's and Ph.D. degrees at the 600-acre campus in southeast Mesa, in an environment characterized by small class sizes, an integrated curriculum and accessible faculty.
