



### DRIVING TO ASU WEST CAMPUS

From Tempe campus Drive north on Rural Road across the Salt River bridge. Take the Loop 202 (Red Mountain Freeway) west to I-10 (Maricopa Freeway). Stay west on I-10 through downtown Phoenix and take I-17 (Black Canyon Freeway) north (about 10 miles) to the Thunderbird Road exit. Proceed west on Thunderbird Road to the 47th Avenue entrance to campus. Follow the signs for visitor parking. If you're coming from ASU's Tempe campus, From Sky Harbor Airport All major airlines fly into Sky Harbor International Airport in Phoenix.

you may be interested in taking the Express Shuttle Service. See below. Go west on I-10 (Maricopa Freeway) through

downtown Phoenix and take I-17 (Black Canyon Freeway) north (about 10 miles) to the Thunderbird Road exit. Proceed west on Thunderbird Road to the 47th Avenue entrance to campus. Follow the signs for visitor parking.

The ASU West Express Shuttle is a direct link between the Tempe and West campuses for \$2 per one-way trip -exact change only


The shuttle runs late August to early December and late January to early May. A detailed schedule is available on the Web. http://www.asu.edu/o

The shuttle is accessible to people with disabilities. The bicycle rack will accommodate two bicycles. There is no service on weekends, university holidays, semester breaks or during the summer



### **POINTS OF INTEREST**

As the West campus at ASU continues to grow and inspire, facilities and amenities of interest to the student body and general public keep pace. From contemporary artwork to a collection of the Valley of the Sun's most diverse plants and trees, the West campus has combined open spaces with unique points of interest. Throughout the school year a wide variety of art displays and theater performances, historical exhibits and scientific works are scheduled for West campus showings.

New to the West campus in late 2006 will be the completion of Phase 1 of a community park that will one day cover a large portion of the southern end of campus.

### SCENIC SPOTS

ASU's West campus has long been acknowledged by surrounding communities as a scenic destination, with its brick and sandstone architecture, many shaded bree arbors and courtyards. The West campus features a collection of some of the West Valley's most diverse plants and trees, including many desert natives. It is provides habitat to hwest fauna, including Blacktail Jackrabbits, Desert Cottontail Rabbits, Harris and Redtail Hawks Road

### ART ON CAMPUS

In 1991, when the first phase of West campus construction of seven buildings was complete, seven accompanying public art pieces also found their place on campus. The pieces, commissioned to match the new campus architecture and layout, tell a story of the past, present and unlimited future history of the campus as well as the past, present and future knowledge represented by the University

### SPORTS AND RECREATION FACILITIES


Diablo Performance & Recreation Center, 602-543-3488


