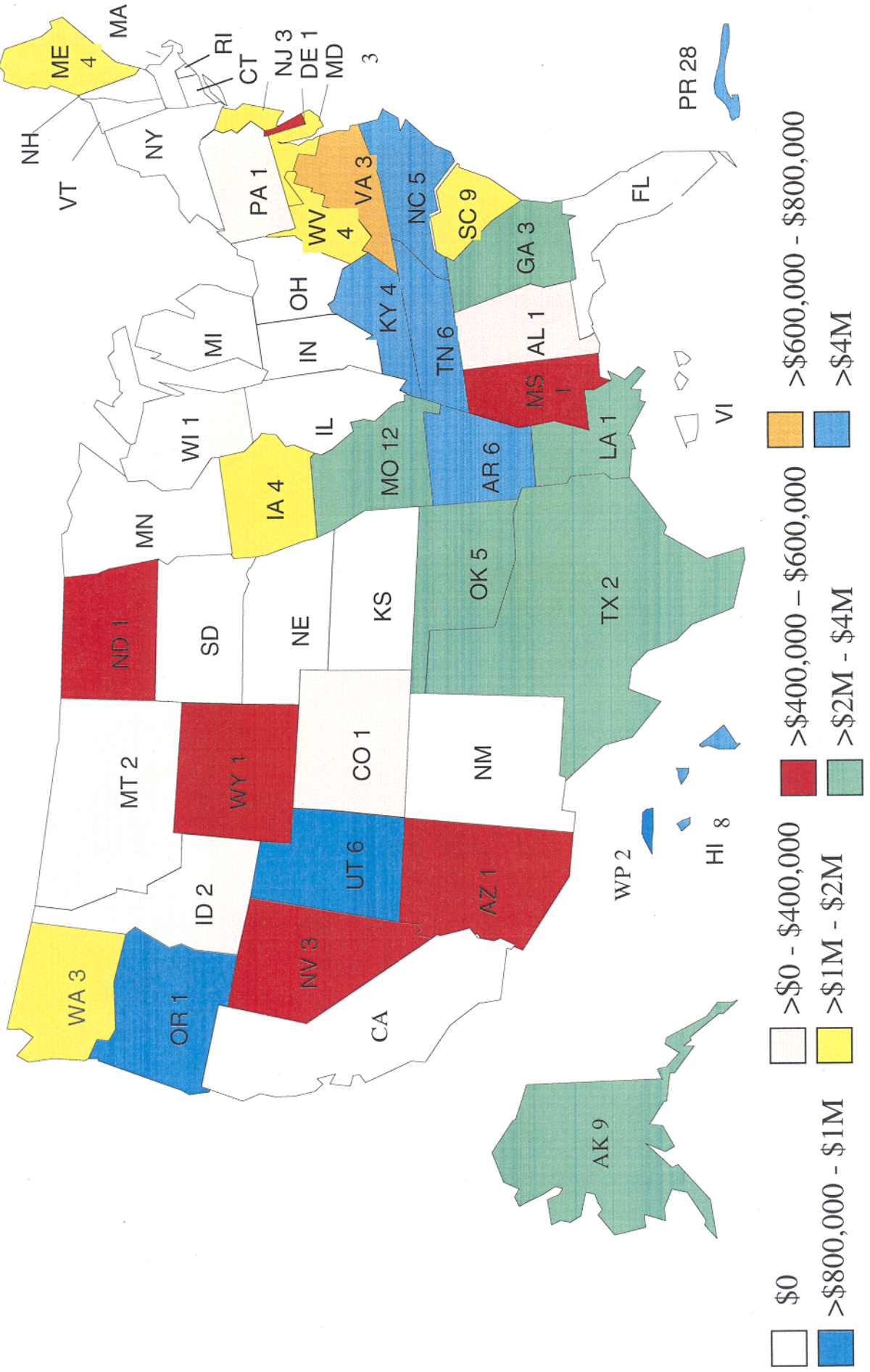

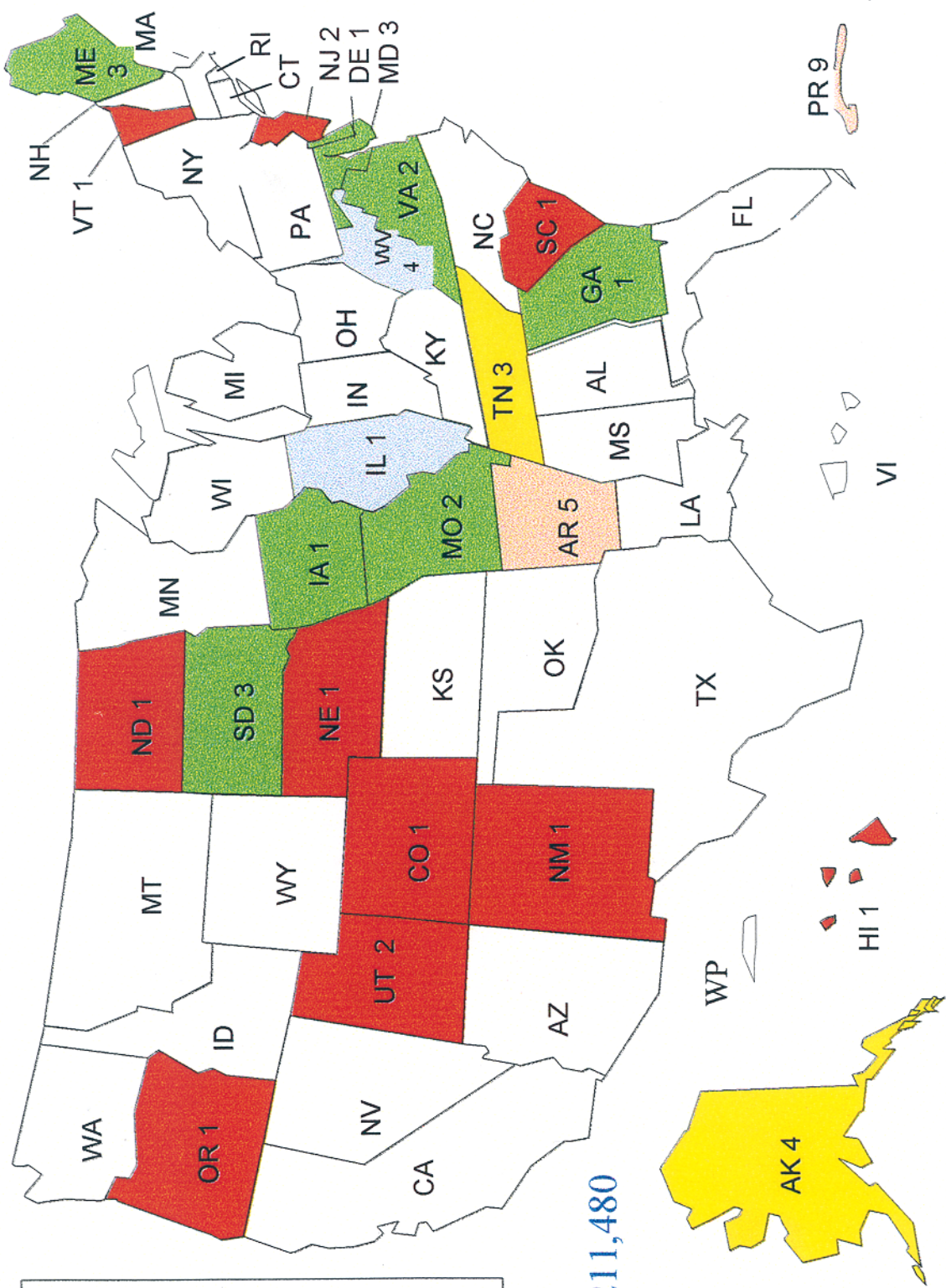
Caseload As of September 30, 2000

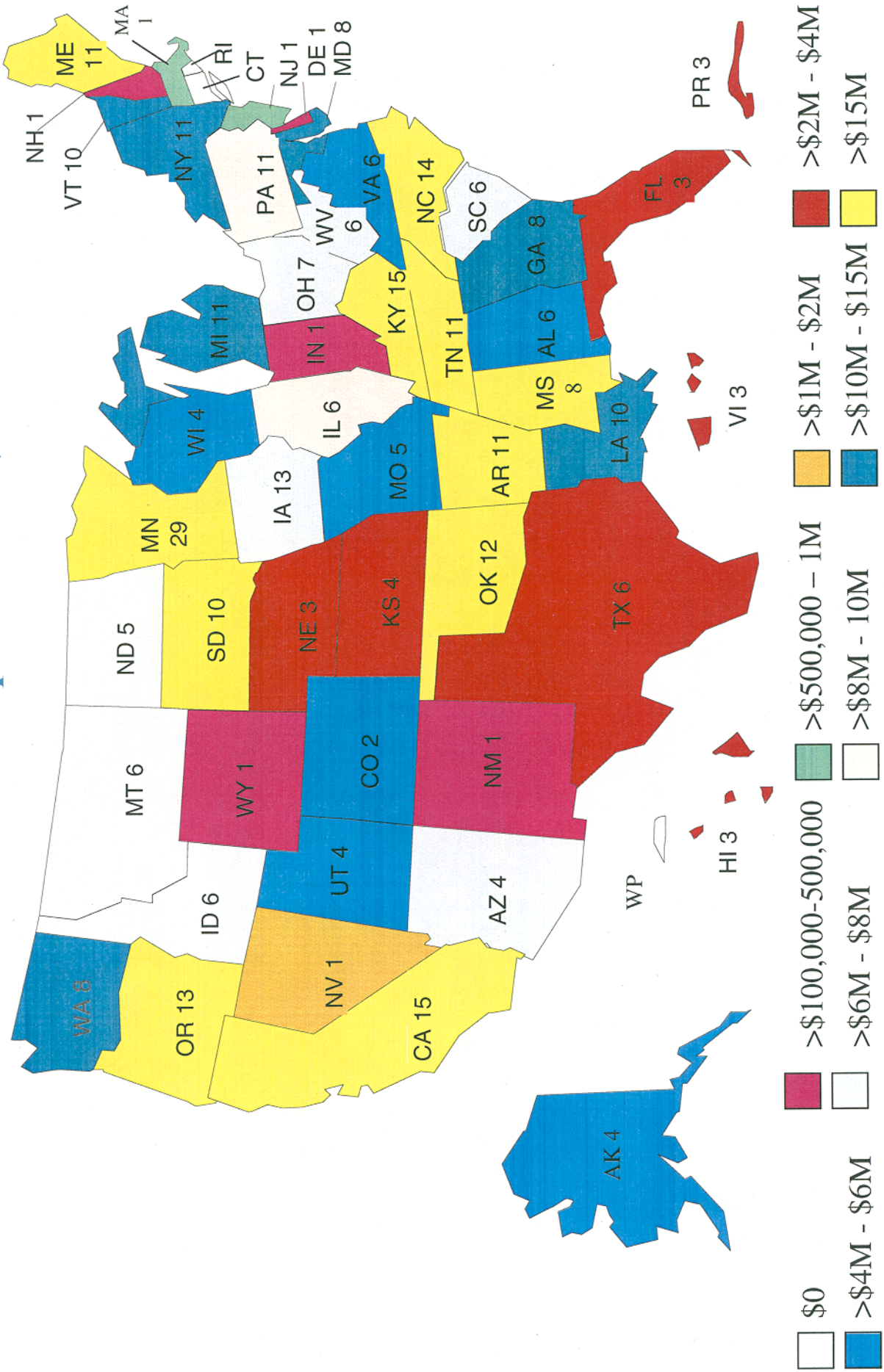

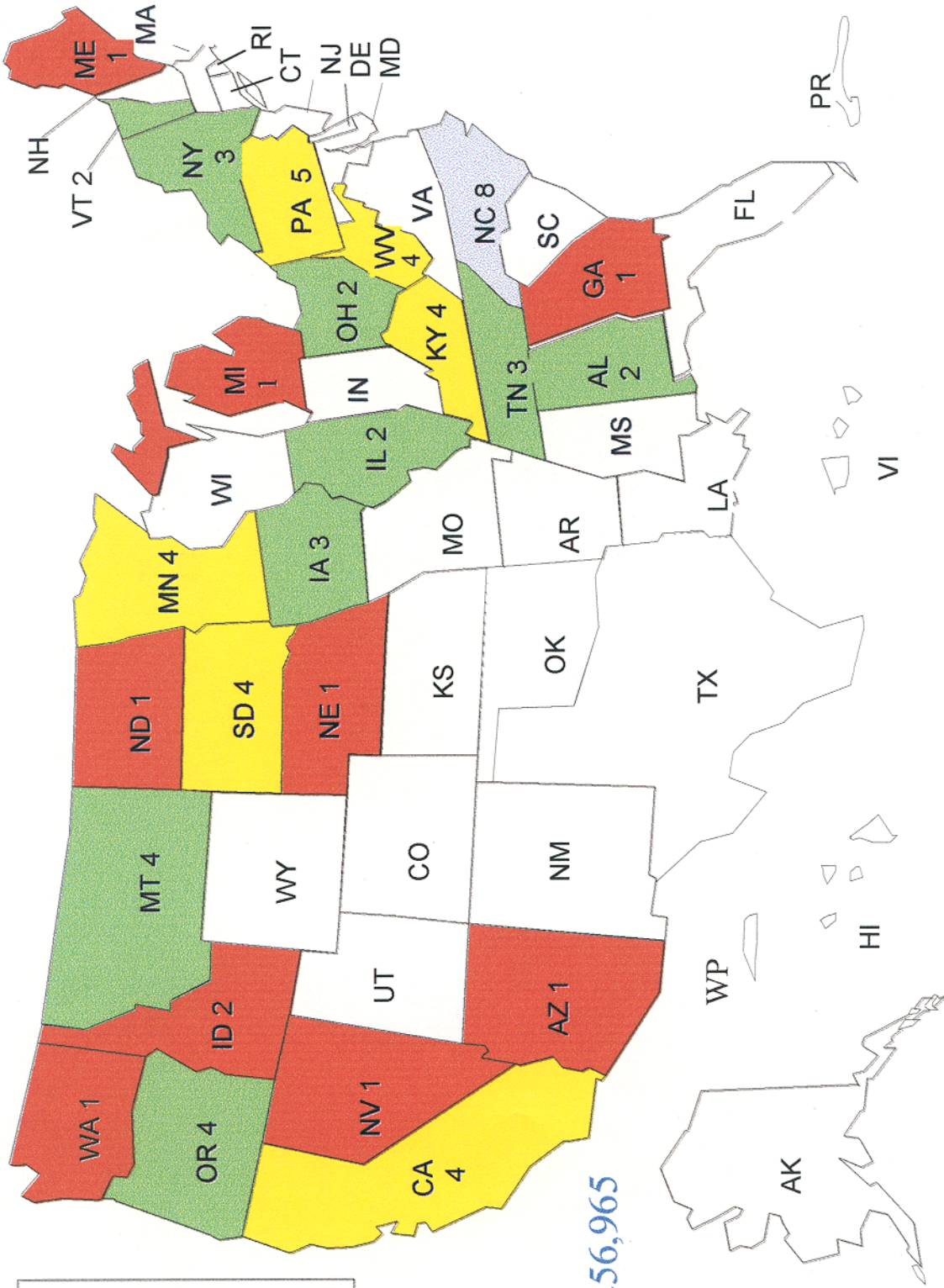
Intermediary Relending Program

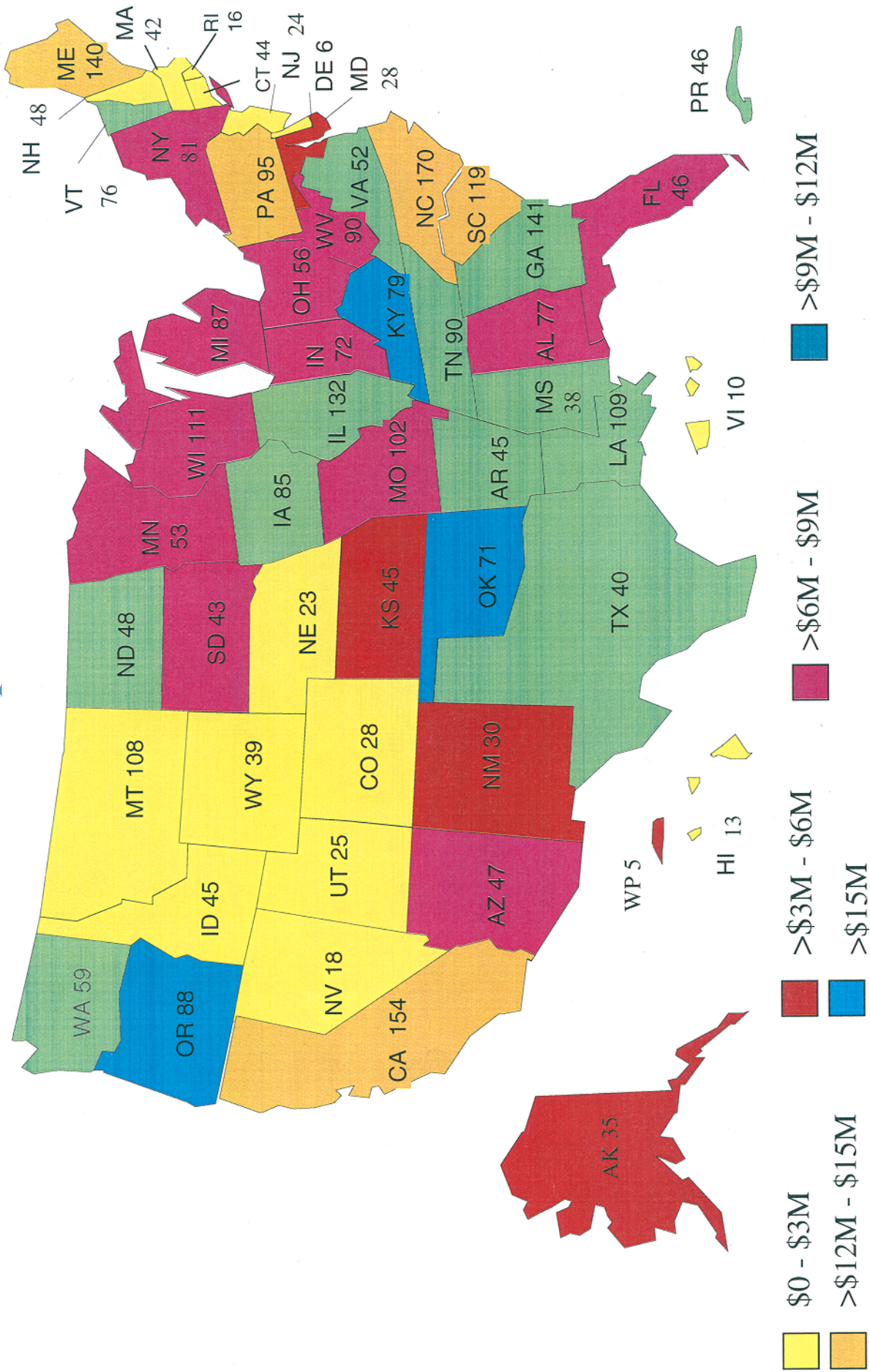

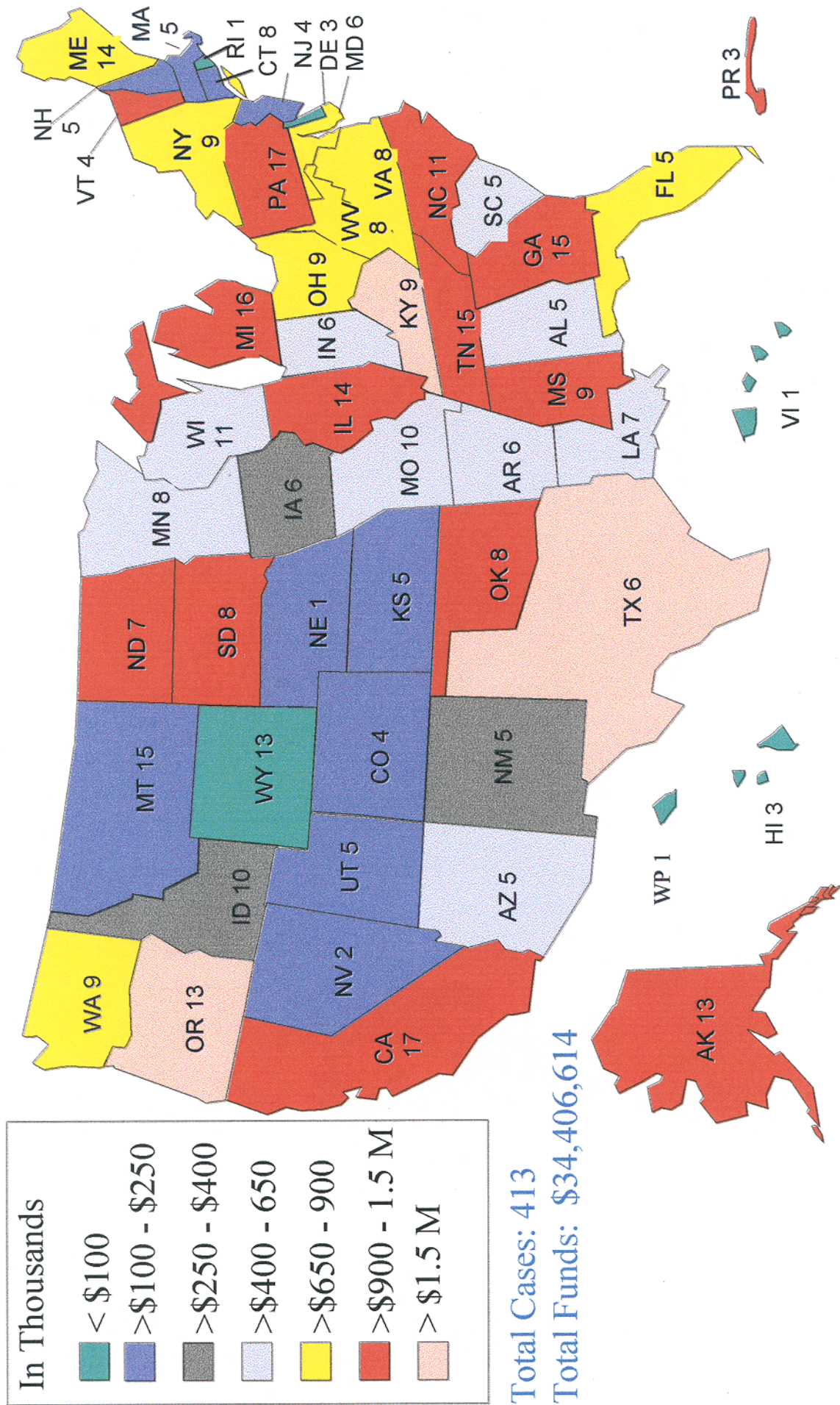
Rural Business Enterprise Grant Program

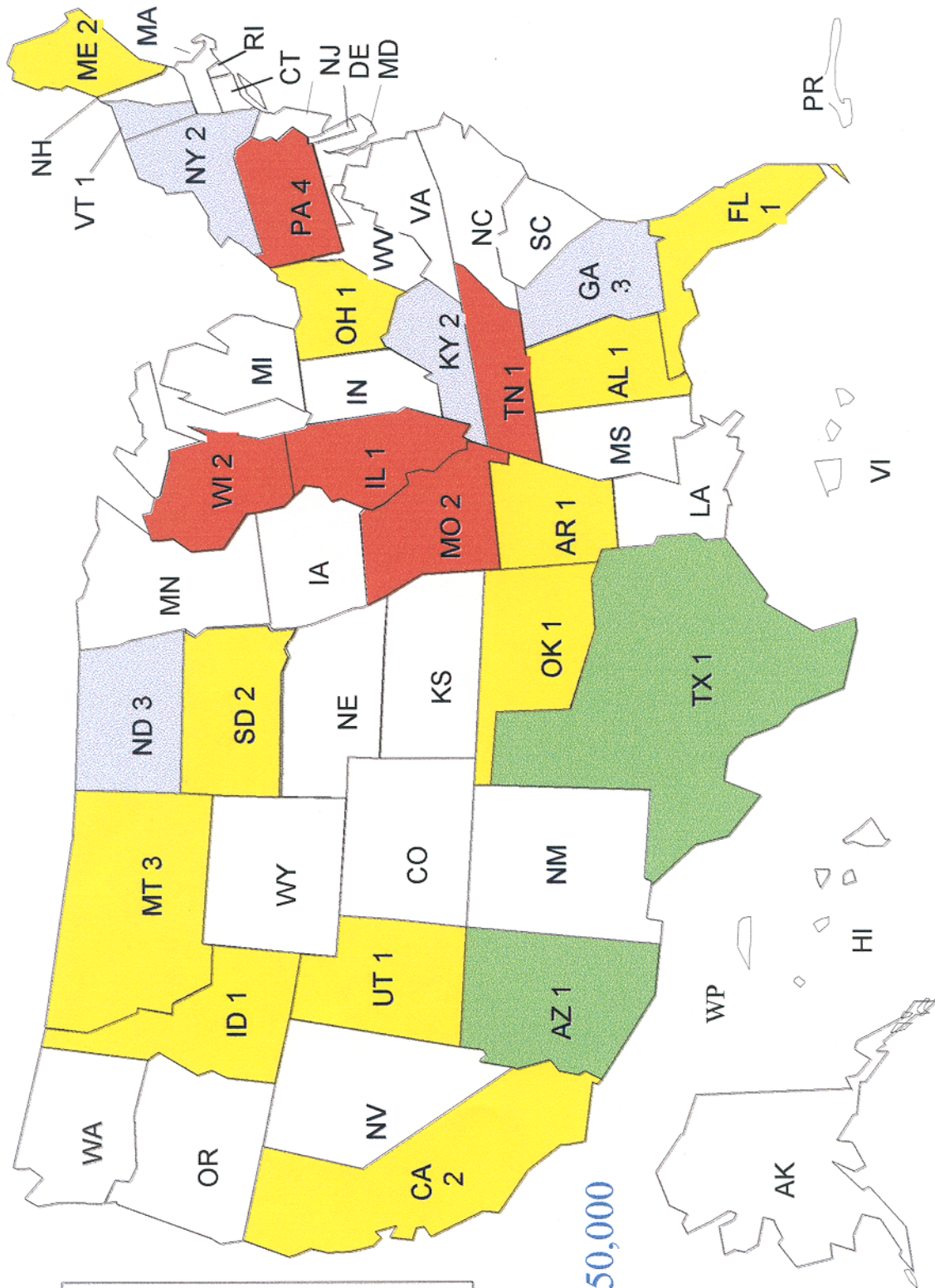

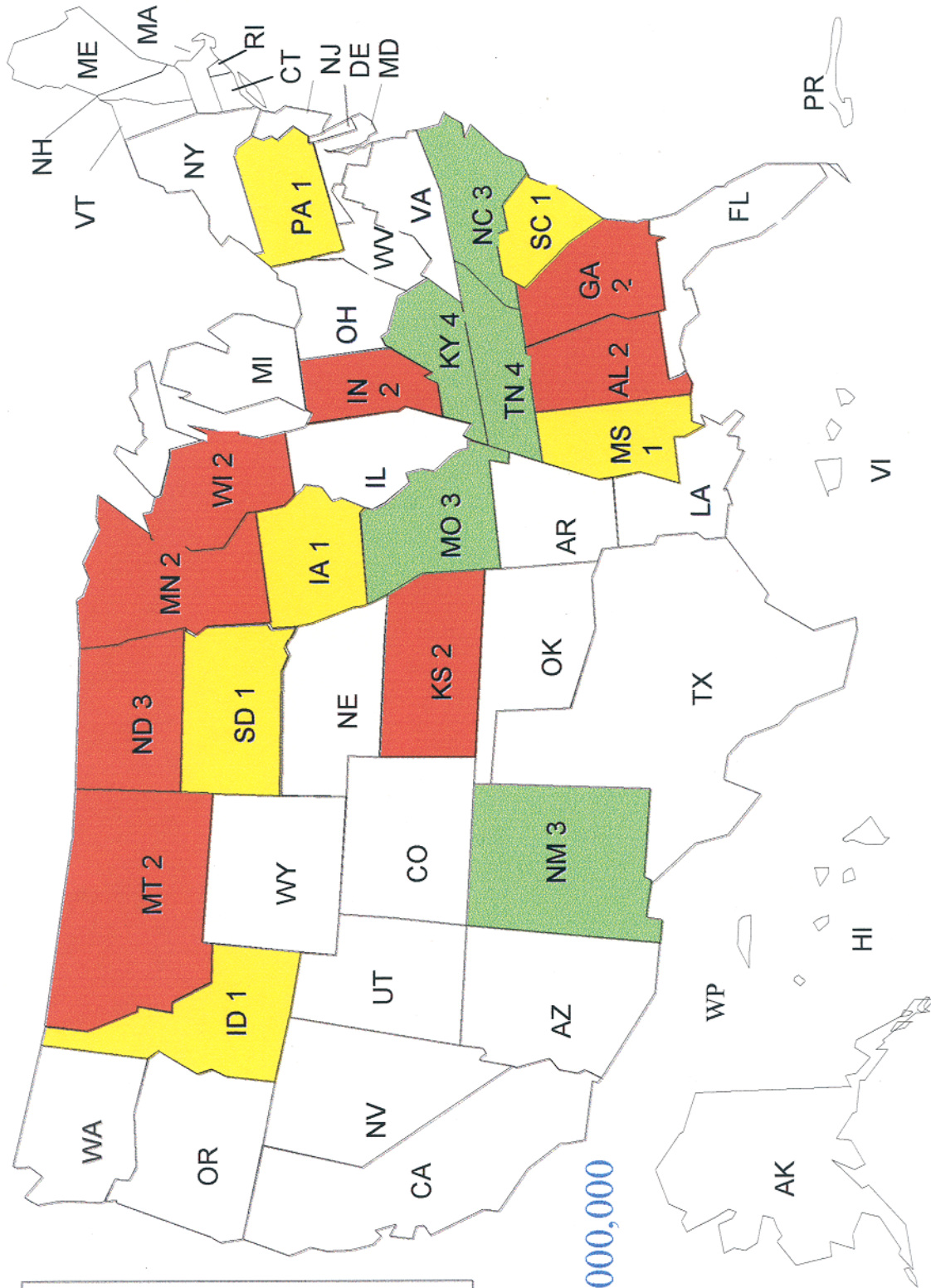
Caseload As of September 30, 2000

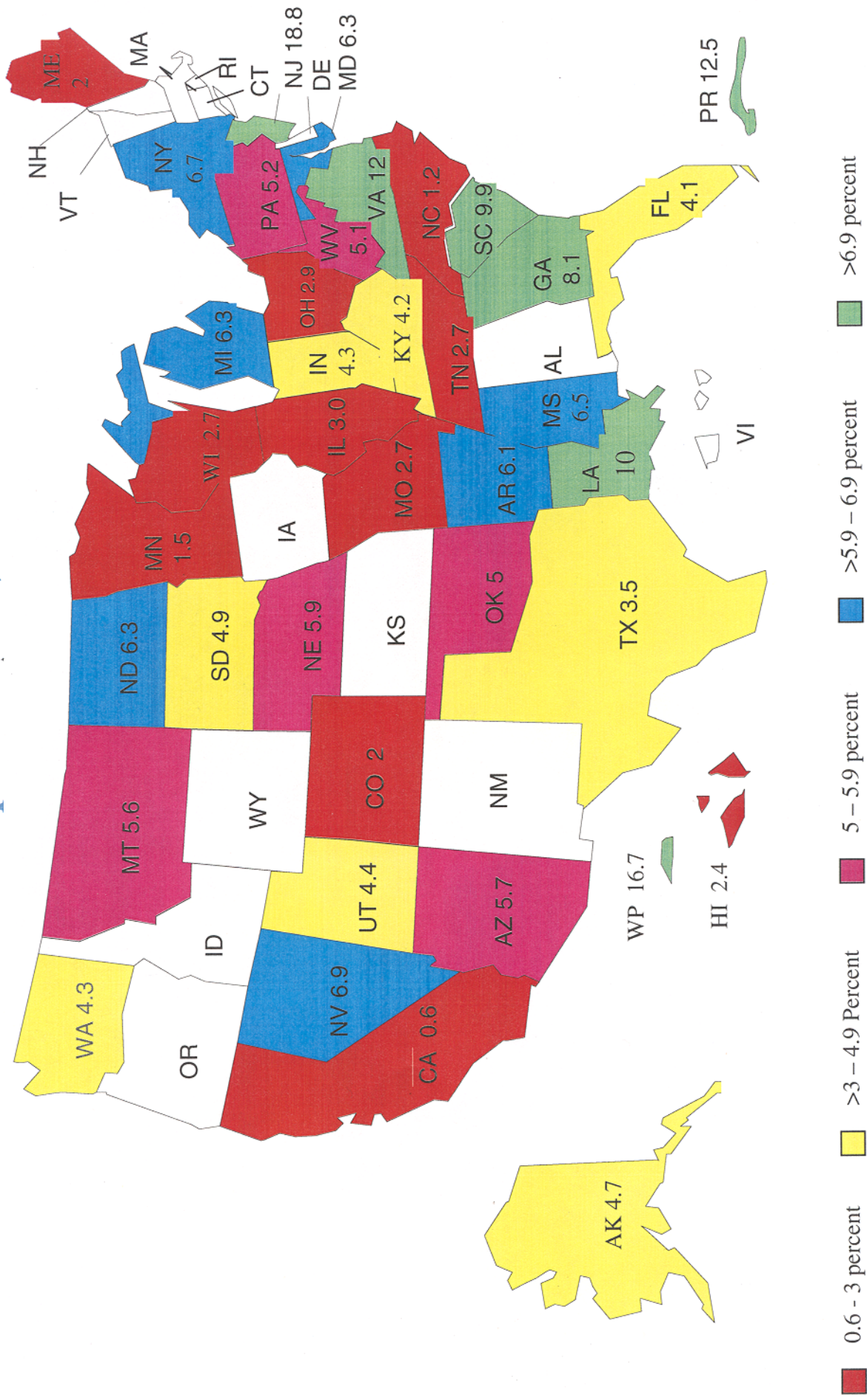

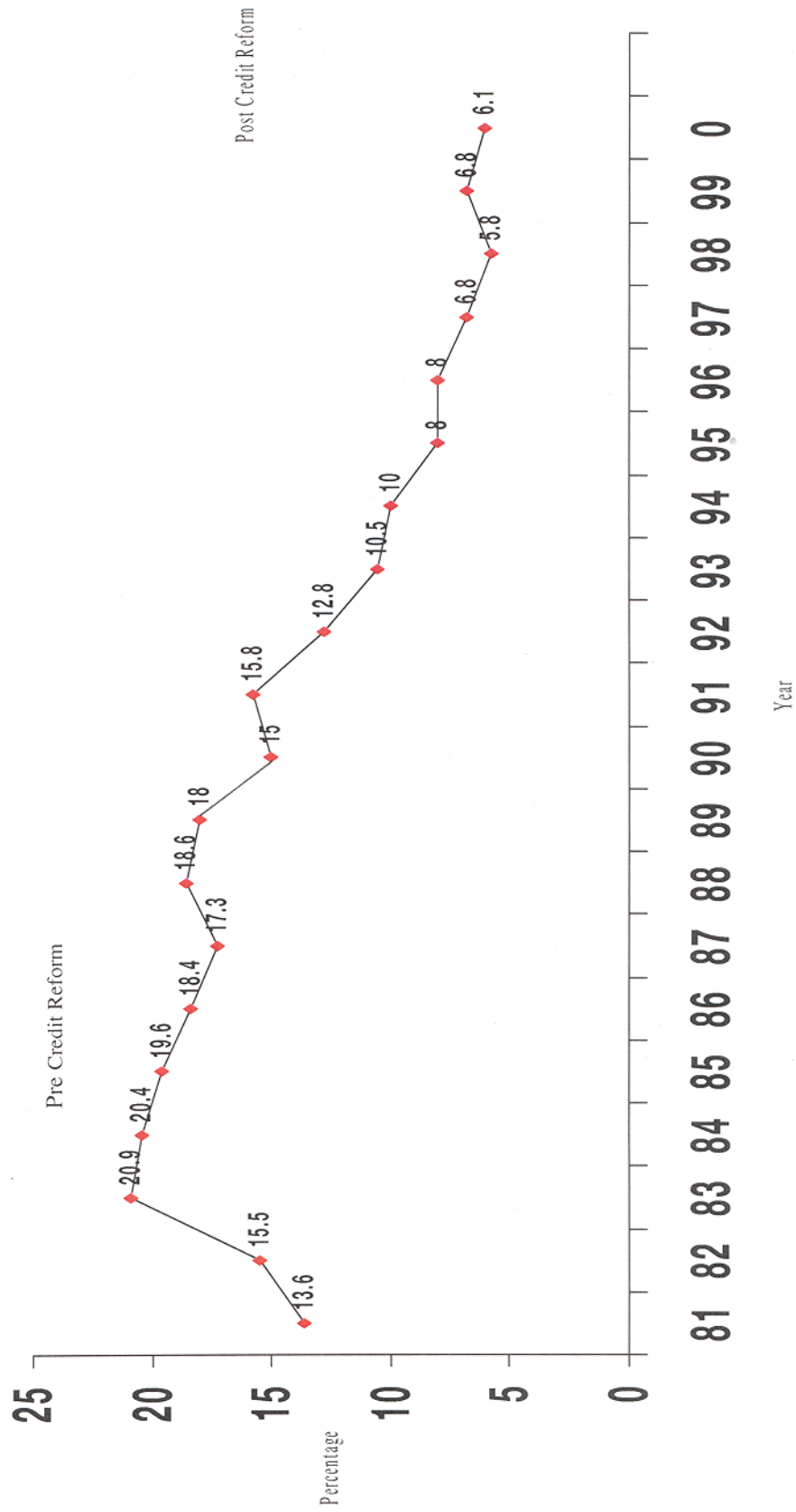
B&I Portfolio Delinquency Status Excluding Bankruptcy
