

## Instructions For:

### USWA Warehouse Operator's Use of form FSA-1007

#### ***INSPECTION CERTIFICATE AND CALCULATION WORKSHEET***

The USWA Warehouse Operator may use form FSA-1007 as an acceptable Nut Weight Certificate by making certain alterations (by computer, typewriter, or rubber stamp). The fourth copy of this document, when used as a weight certificate, is the basic source document for movement of peanuts into and out of the warehouse for any purpose. (See form FSA-1007 exhibit on page 4.)

#### *Section Q - Remarks*

<b>Fld Name / Item No.</b>	<b>Instruction</b>
Box One	Enter or print the Caption "United States Warehouse Act Nut Weight Certificate".
(Note)	Unless electronic form FSA-1007 can be fully audited electronically, the fourth copy of a paper FSA-1007 or an individual hard copy of the electronic form, must be retained as DACO's copy and maintained in a numerical file for both inbound and outbound shipments. The warehouse examiner will be verifying inbound and outbound peanut movement by this document.
Box Two	Enter or print the Name and Location of the warehouse.

#### *At the top.*

<b>Fld Name / Item No.</b>	<b>Instruction</b>
Box Three	Enter the Buying Point Number and Location in the box provided.

*Above Section II.*

<b>Fld Name / Item No.</b>	<b>Instruction</b>
Box Four	Check the box indicating whether the nuts are being weighed into or out of the warehouse.
Box Five	At the bottom of the form, preprint the consecutive number of the certificate followed by a two place alpha buying point or alternate warehouse designation. Total field length 11 characters.
(Note)	Unless electronic form FSA-1007 can be fully audited electronically, the fourth copy of a paper FSA-1007 or an individual hard copy of the electronic form, must be retained as DACO's copy and maintained in a numerical file for both inbound and outbound shipments. The warehouse examiner will be verifying inbound and outbound peanut movement by this document.
(Note)	The warehouse operator must contact KCCO – Tim Mehl, Chief, Warehouse License and Examination Division at (816) 926-6417 to submit their series of numbers to be used as weight certificate numbers (DACO Control Numbers). A separate series must be approved and used for each receiving and shipping location and warehouse.

<b>Fld Name / Item No.</b>	<b>Instruction</b>
Box Six	Print the gross weight, tare weight, and net weight of the peanuts in items A, B, and C respectively.

*In Box Provided above Section Q (Dated Signature of Licensed Weigher).*

<b>Fld Name / Item No.</b>	<b>Instruction</b>
Box Seven	The Licensed Weigher enters a signature and a date of signature. Upon written request by the warehouse operator, DACO may authorize the use of facsimile or electronic signatures.
(Note)	Each location referred to in this instruction has at least one warehouse operator-approved weigher. For scales to be usable, (1) warehouse operators must have control of the scales used to weigh peanuts, (2) the scales must be inspected and certified by a State agency or a qualified scale company, (3) a copy of the inspection report must be maintained at the warehouse office for the warehouse examiner's review, and (4) the scale must be checked by the warehouse operator for accuracy on a routine basis.
(Note)	Unless electronic form FSA-1007 can be fully audited electronically, the fourth copy of a paper FSA-1007 or an individual hard copy of the electronic form, must be retained as DACO's copy and maintained in a numerical file for both inbound and outbound shipments. The warehouse examiner will be verifying inbound and outbound peanut movement by this document.
