SANCTIONS AMENDMENT**

(This is a Continuous Amendment)

This amendment modifies the provisions of the Common Crop Insurance Policy Basic Provisions (CCIP), Crop Revenue Coverage Insurance Policy Basic Provisions (CRC), Revenue Assurance Insurance Policy Basic Provisions (RA), Group Risk Plan of Insurance Basic Provisions (GRP), and the Group Risk Income Protection Plan of Insurance Basic Provisions (GRIP) for the 2009 and succeeding crop years for all crops with a 2009 contract change date on or after January 31, 2009, for the 2010 and succeeding crop years for all crops with a 2010 contract change date on or after January 31, 2009, and for the 2011 and succeeding crop years for all crops with a 2010 contract change date prior to January 31, 2009, as follows:
